### Register for Paddle Craft Safety

Become certified in skills for canoe, kayak, and stand-up paddleboard, covering trip preparation and advanced rescue techniques. This is a two-part course:

**Part 1** (Classroom): Wednesday, May 27, 2026, 7:00 PM – 9:30 PM at the **\*\*Norris Scout Service Center\*\***, St. Charles, IL.

**Part 2** (On the Water): Sunday, June 7, 2026, 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM at Silver Springs State Park

### Key Requirements:

- Minimum age: 15
- Current **\*\*Safety Afloat\*\*** training
- Passing the BSA Swimmer Test

**For both events, all activities require qualified adult supervision (21+).**
