NYLT is open to qualified youth in all troops, teams, crews or ships. Scouts

In a Troop:

- At least 13 years old by June 9, 2019.
- At least a First Class Rank.
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law.
- Have attended ILST or ILSC training.

In a Crew:

- Have knowledge of basic outdoor skills (cooking, fire-building, tying/lashing, etc.)
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law.
- Have attended ILST or ILSC training.

EVERYONE SHOULD:

- Hold a leadership position in your home unit, or have strong leadership potential.
- Agree to practice the skills learned from NYLT back at your home unit.
- Have long-term camping experience.
- Have a Unit Leader recommendation and parent agreement.


