Competition! Learning! Teamwork! Fun!

COMPETITION

Scout teams work through accident scenarios in 20-minute periods. Judges score each team's first-aid knowledge, analysis of situations, and delivery of quality first-aid to victims. Team scores are totaled for the scenarios. Prizes are awarded to top-scoring teams.

LEARNING

At the end of each scenario, the judge reviews the team's performance, indicating where the team made correct decisions and whether they provided appropriate care. The judge shows the scouts how they could improve their treatment of victims.

TEAMWORK

A different team member is selected as problem leader for each scenario. The problem leader must organize the team's delivery of first aid to victims. Scouts use their teamwork skills to handle the different parts of the treatment. One team member notifies emergency resources. For one scenario, a team member demonstrates CPR.



A team member contacts emergency responders, giving accurate information about the location, the victims, and the treatments.



FUN

After the last scenario, teams compete in a “Goodies Contest” while the official results are tallied. The team provides written answers to a short test that encourages use of first aid resources and the pooling of team knowledge. Bags of goodies go to high-scoring teams.
