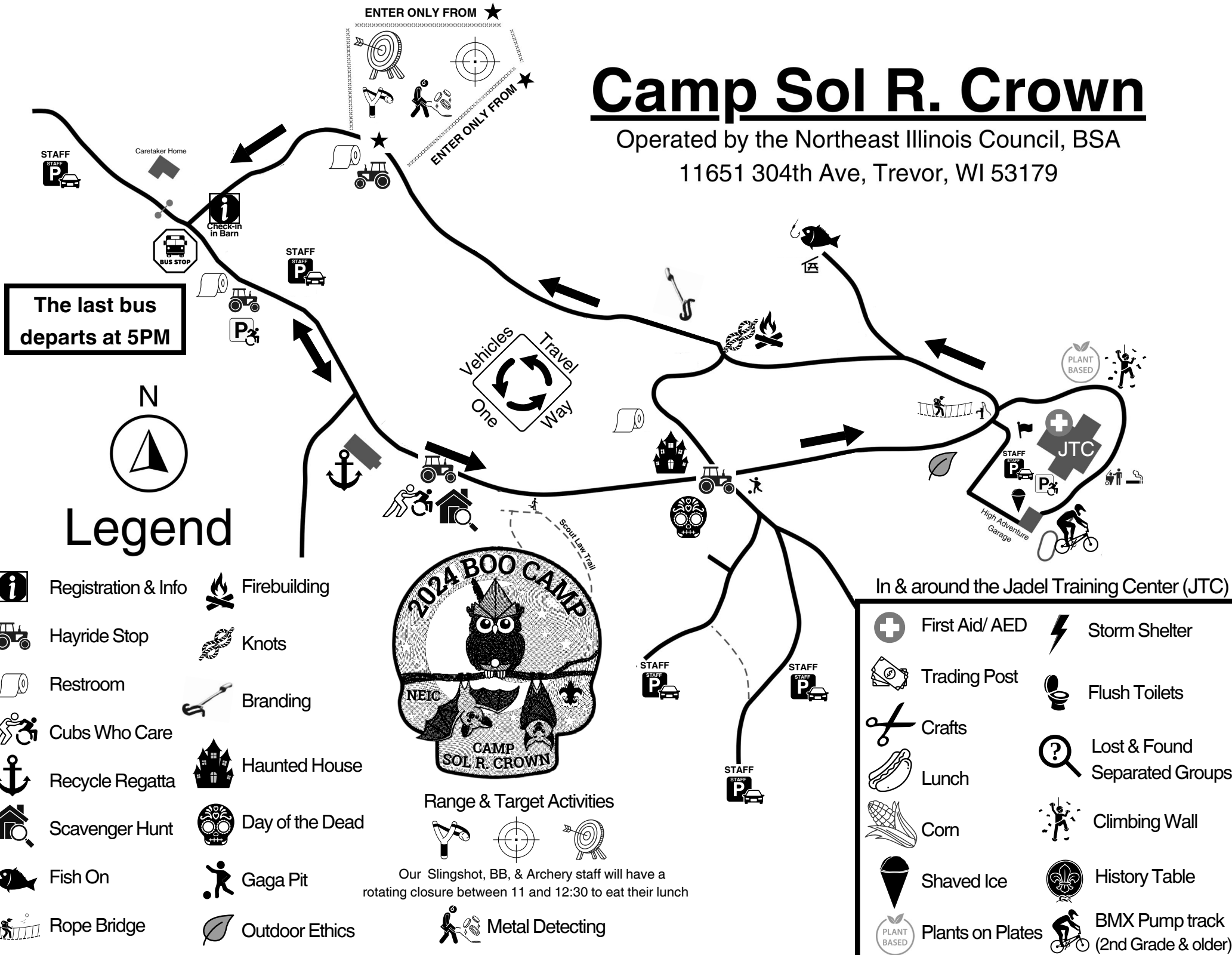

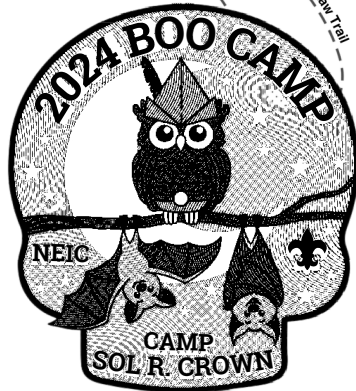


The last bus
