Dear Scoutmaster, Venture Crew, Sea Ship Advisor:

National Youth Leadership Training is a seven-day outdoor experience for Scout Troop, Venture Crew and Sea Scout leaders. It is the next step in the BSA training continuum after Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops/Crews/Ships. The course teaches Scouts more about leadership through training sessions, group activities and games, and personal challenges. At NYLT, Scouts apply leadership skills in real-world situations to help their patrols achieve success.

Scouting recognizes that Scoutmasters and Advisers have the responsibility of training their youth leaders using ILST and ILSC. The purpose of the NYLT program is not to assume that role, but to support it. The objectives of the course are:

- To give the participants the confidence and knowledge to run the troop program.
- To give participants a basic knowledge of Be-Know-Do leadership model and help relate these skills to their troop roles and responsibilities.
- To allow Scouts to share ideas and experiences with Scouts from other units.
- To create an atmosphere where Scouts will experience Scouting at its best.
- To enhance the relationship between the participant and his Scoutmaster.
- To have fun.

Course Dates: June 15-21, 2025 at Ma-Ka-Ja-Wan Scout Reservation

New Fees/Same Deadlines:

- \$340 Early Discount Fee if paid-in-full by Jan 19, 2025 (by 11:59PM if paid online; by 4:00 PM if paid at the office).
- \$365 Regular Fee if paid-in-full Jan 20 Feb 28, 2025. The Youth's fee will no longer have the discount applied if there is an unpaid balance, and the full \$365 will be charged for Scouts who are registered starting Jan 20, 2025.
- \$390 Late Fee if paid-in-full on or after March 1, 2025. Any Scout with a balance on March 1 will automatically have an additional \$25 late fee applied, bringing their total cost to \$390.
- **REGISTRATION CLOSES:** May 10, 2025 (11:59 PM), no exceptions.
- May 10: The balance for all registrants is due. Cancellations after this date cannot be refunded.

IMPORTANT: The scout store and main desk staff only "receipt" payments. They DO NOT apply or load Scout data into the registration system. Any payments that are mailed or brought to the scout store/office must arrive by 4:00 PM on the deadline dates to allow us time to apply those payments online before the workday ends.
