



National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT)

Personal Equipment Checklist

Only official Scouting America (SA) uniform is acceptable

Be prepared for an overnight hike & living/working in an outdoor “wilderness” camp site

REQUIRED (PLEASE properly ID ALL your clothing and equipment PRIOR to arrival at NYLT)

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| <p>☐ SA Uniform headgear of your troop/crew/ship *</p> <p>☐ SA Uniform shirt short sleeves **</p> <p>☐ SA Uniform shorts or “BSA switchback” slacks (2 pairs) **</p> <p>☐ SA Uniform socks (3 pairs minimum*) knee high or crew</p> <p>☐ SA belt and buckle</p> <p>☐ SA Neckerchief, troop or team or Crew</p> <p>☐ SA Neckerchief slide</p> <p>☐ Camping air mattress/foam pad</p> <p>☐ Hiking Boots, waterproof (NO tennis/casual footwear allowed)</p> <p>☐ One Change of boots, as desired</p> <p>☐ Raincoat, poncho, or rain suit (MANDATORY!)</p> <p>☐ Sweatshirt, jacket, or Jac-Shirt (for cold weather)</p> <p>☐ Underclothing (3 sets minimum)</p> <p>☐ Pajamas/camp warmer/sweat suit</p> <p>☐ SA Field Uniform (1 course T-shirt provided with fee)</p> <p>☐ Work gloves (leather or similar for camp chores)</p> <p>☐ Towel (for available hot showers)</p> <p>☐ Washcloth</p> <p>☐ Toothbrush and paste</p> <p>☐ Compass (official SA or equivalent preferred)</p> <p>☐ Hand soap and container (biodegradable “Camp Soap” OK)</p> <p>☐ Required/prescribed and “OTC” medication:</p> | <p>☐ Wrist Watch (MANDATORY - NO CELL PHONE or SMART WATCH use during course!) – no internet!</p> <p>☐ Alarm Clock (battery operated)</p> <p>☐ Medium-size Backpack (for overnight hike)</p> <p>☐ Backpacking Tent (*waterproofed, lightweight 2 to 4-person for overnight hike)</p> <p>☐ Ground cloth (10’ X 10’ waterproof or plastic)</p> <p>☐ Knife, fork, spoon (SA or equivalent)</p> <p>☐ Canteen/Water Bottle (1 provided with fee)</p> <p>☐ Plate, bowl, cup (SA Mess Kit or equivalent)</p> <p>☐ Warm Sleeping bag/blankets (liner/sheets) – 30°F bag</p> <p>☐ Flashlight, with spare batteries & bulb</p> <p>☐ Bandanas (as needed)</p> <p>☐ Sewing kit (simple, for clothing emergencies)</p> <p>☐ Personal, simple first aid kit (NO Meds Please!)</p> <p>☐ Ball-point pen; pencil (1 provided with fee)</p> <p>☐ Pocket knife (4” max)</p> <p style="color: blue;">(absolutely no sheath knives are allowed!)</p> <p>☐ Official BSA/Venture/Sea Scout Handbook equivalent for reference</p> <p>☐ Insect & Tick repellent (Pump, NO Aerosols allowed)</p> <p>☐ Sunscreen (Tube or Pump, NO Aerosols)</p> |
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ALL medications, including any/all “over the counter (OTC)” products MUST be in a Zip-Lock plastic bag, which includes a completed and signed “Medical Permission Slip”. NYLT staff cannot dispense any antacid, allergy, or Tylenol WITHOUT your permission being listed on this form. Note also: NYLT STAFF does NOT stock any OTC products!

*One NYLT cap is provided from registration, **Only SA or plain** headgear/clothing is allowed

** If for religious or medical reasons, long trousers/shirts must be worn, this is allowed.

NOTES — Most items can be borrowed from a Unit if scout does not own them. Venture Scouts may substitute for appropriate authorized Crew Uniform. Everyone must be in “official” SA Field uniform (*the first five items on the required list*) when they travel to/arrive at NYLT; this uniform is also worn most times during course. Participants may not use foot lockers or trunks at their outdoor “wilderness” campsite and must be able to carry all their equipment by themselves, for at least one mile. A standard patrol box issue is provided and will be assigned to each Patrol for their use during the course.

OPTIONAL Items:

Mirror (<i>metal</i>)	Comb
Wash basin (<i>plastic or canvas; shower facilities are available</i>)	Clothesline and clothes pins for drying items
Coat hangers to keep uniforms neat	Sharpening stone
Personal Scouting equipment	Olive long trousers (<i>1 pair</i>) **
Laundry Soap (<i>if your son/daughter will need to do laundry</i>)	Extra socks (<i>2 pairs</i>)
Sunglasses	Pillow/case
Extra prescription eyeglasses/contacts	Camping Merit Badge book for reference
Religious book(s)	Pioneering M.B. book for reference
Moccasins or sneakers (<i>campsite wear only</i>)	Cooking M.B. book for reference

Insignia and Uniform Inspection-Before attending NYLT, see that all SA rank badges and insignia are properly placed on uniform: <https://www.scouting.org/resources/insignia-guide/> and <http://tr52.com/UniformInspection.pdf>.

Upon arrival to Camp Wabanningo, “contraband” and medicines will be collected by the Troop Guides and secured for the week. Medication will be administered by the medical staff/officer.

All items will be returned for the bus ride home.
