

Camporee FAQ - Public

When is the Camporee?

The public is invited to our Camporee on Saturday, September 23. Scouts' Camporee experience runs from Friday, September 22, through Sunday, September 24.



How do I register my family?

Online registration is open now at <https://scoutingevent.com/138-2023FallCamporeePUBLIC>. You can also register in person in downtown Ottawa's Washington Square Park (100 E. LaFayette) and Jordan Block (101 W. Main) starting at 1:30 on Saturday, September 23.

What do we do there?

First, check in at one of the registration stations (see above) where your child(ren) will be issued a wristband that will allow your child(ren) to participate in most, but not all, activities.

Some of the activities will include: Boat and car races, Touch-a-Truck, meet someone from NASA, Solve-a-Crime, 3-D printing, tour the Reddick Mansion, meet a Lincoln impersonator, run through an inflatable obstacle course, see a blacksmith at work and more!

Then, visit any of our program areas – located in Washington Square Park, the Jordan Block, Rigden Park (620 W. Jackson) or Fox River Park (717 Hudson Street) – and see what fun is waiting for you there! You are welcome to participate from 1:30 p.m. through 4:30 p.m., when all program stations close. You may park in any City of Ottawa parking lot – they're all free! See the **Event Parking Map** in this FAQ for more information.

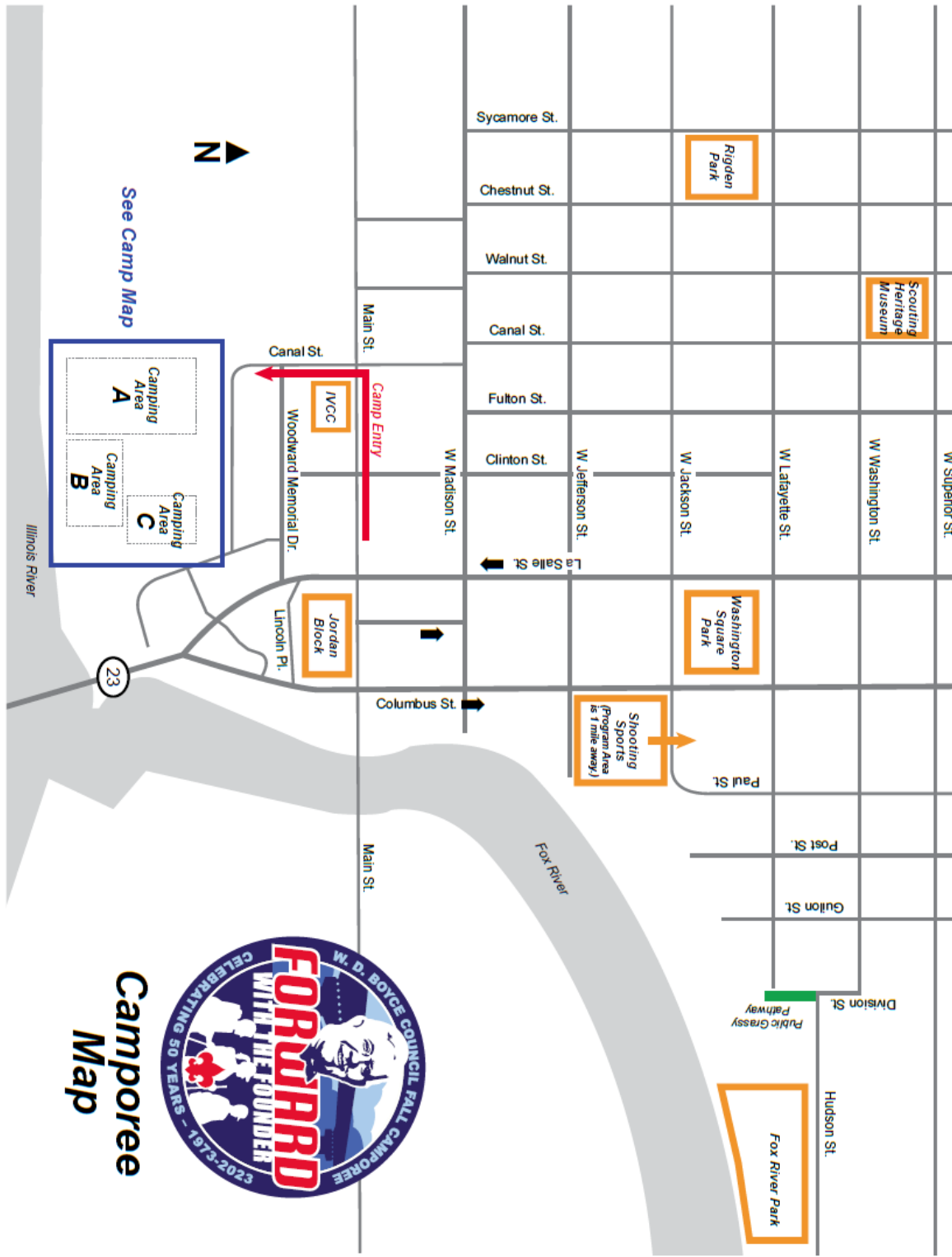
What should we wear?
