## Become a Certified Cub Rangemaster

Are you ready to take your leadership skills to the next level and guide our Cub Scouts in their thrilling range activities adventures? Join us for the Cub Scout Rangemaster Training program! Cub Rangemaster combines Cub BB Rangemaster (course code CS32) with Cub Archery Rangemaster (course code CS31) and certifies you for 2 years to safely assist with or lead the following activities:

- Cub Scout BB target activities
- Cub Scout Archery activities
- Slingshot activities

These certifications are particularly important to assist with Cub Daycamp, Cub Launch and Cub Resident camp programs that include target activities.

## Training Schedule

- **Date: Sunday, April 19**
- Time: 12 PM to apx. 5 PM
- Location: Ingersoll Scout Reservation (tentatively: Shotgun building)
- Duration: Apx. 5 hours, training will take longer with more participants as everyone needs the opportunity to feel comfortable with the hands-on training.

## What You'll Learn

- Safety protocols and procedures for operating Cub range activities
- How to set up and maintain a BB target range and an archery target range
- Effective training techniques for Cub Scouts

## What You'll Need

- Notebook and pen
- Suitable outdoor clothing (hands-on exercises will be outdoors, rain or shine!)
- Sunscreen / wide brimmed hat
- Water bottle and snack
- Personal eye protection if desired, eye protection is also provided
- Completed Range Standard Operating Procedure
- List of questions from your review of the course material
- Enthusiasm!

  - Are you new to Cub Rangemaster, or is this a recertification?
- New as of Sept. 2024 is an online training course, "Range Activities Safety". We are asking that all course participants complete this course before attending Rangemaster training. It's 30 minutes long and useful both to leaders new to range activities and as a reminder to experienced leaders.
- Well ahead of the course you should receive course materials and a template for a range SOP (standard operating procedure). (Hopefully at least 4 weeks ahead, send email inquiries (nags) to [rangetargetactivitiescommittee @ wdboyce.org](mailto:rangetargetactivitiescommittee@wdboyce.org) if we're running late on this!)
  - Spend time with the course material until you're comfortable with the concepts. This will likely take at least 2 hours and is perhaps best done over a couple of evenings. Write down your questions to bring to the in-person course!
  - Once you're comfortable with the material, turn the Range SOP template into a completed Range SOP. If you're familiar with the location used for your district Cub Camp, use that as a location. We're going to review these in district groups to compare and discuss variations in procedures.
