Parking Instructions

- All vehicles must park in the upper parking lot adjacent to the main lodge.
- No parking in marked off zone next to the hockey rink, this is a puck landing zone.
- No parking permitted on access roads or in fire lanes to ensure emergency access.
- Drop-off zone will be marked near the main lodge for quick unloading; drivers must move vehicles immediately after drop-off.
- Volunteers will direct traffic and assist with parking from 9:15 to 10:15 AM.
- Accessible parking is available; please notify registration staff in advance if needed.

Supervision

- Each scout must have a parent/guardian for the entire event or have made arrangements with their Pack to provide 2 deep leadership

- Scouts require their parents or Pack leaders as we are not equipped with enough leadership to keep scouts safe going from station to station without your help
- THIS IS NOT A DROP OFF EVENT!
- Lions and Tigers MUST have their Parent or Guardian with them at all times.
- If your Pack is providing leadership and you arrive before them, you must stay with your scout until they show up

Passport

- All Scouts will receive a passport when they check in at registration
- Present your passport at each station to be signed off
- Return your completed passport to registration at the end of the day to receive your event patch

What to Bring

- Medical forms
 - Bring your medical form part A and B. We will be checking for them at registration. It is better if you have them filled out in advance. You can print a copy of the form at <https://www.scouting.org/health-and-safety/ahmr/>
 - Medical forms must also be filled out for any adult or sibling that will be on sight
 - You will hang on to your own medical form. If first aid is needed, it will be the first thing the Medical Officer will ask for.
- All scouts should dress for the weather
 - Dress in layers
 - Hats, coats, boots, snow pants, ect
- Bring cash for Ice Skating and Snack Shack
- If there is snow, there will be a spot for sledding. Scouts should bring their own sled
- All Scouts should bring their 6 essentials. There will be a station near registration where you can show your 6 essentials and get entered into a drawing to win some cool prizes. The more categories you have, the more chances you have of winning.

Your 6 essentials are as follows

○ First aid kit	○ Water
○ Sun protection	○ Trail snack
○ Flashlight	○ Whistle

- Non breakable mug for Hot Cocoa. Help us reduce our environmental impact by bringing your own mug

Ice Skating

- There is an additional \$5 fee to be paid at the rink entrance
- Please bring cash for this fee

- Please bring cash
