* You should be prepared for cold weather by including extra sets of long trousers and long-sleeved shirts. Also, if for personal reasons long trousers must be worn, this is permissible.

** If you do not have a lightweight tent for backpacking, borrow one for the week.

Note: Everyone will be in official uniform (the first five items on the list) before moving to the campsite. Scouts must use their pack for getting their gear from the drop-off place to the campsite. Attendees will not use suitcases, trunks, or footlockers at their campsites. Normal prescribed patrol equipment will be issued at camp, such as wall tents with a floorboard, cots, and dining canopies with poles. Before coming to camp, be sure all badges and insignia are properly placed on your Scout uniform.
