General Information

BSA REGISTRATION

Each youth must be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America in order to participate in the events. A completed application form including parental information and signatures must be present at check-in for all prospective Scouts who are not yet registered. At least one (1) adult should be on-site at the Merit Badge Fair for each unit at all times.

FEES AND REGISTRATION

ADVANCE REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED. NO WALK-INS WILL BE ACCEPTED. Units may register online via the Hoosier Trails Council calendar at http://www.HoosierTrailsBSA.org. The cost of registration will be \$7.00 per person. Registrations received after 5:00 PM on Friday, March 24th, will *NOT* be guaranteed an event patch.
