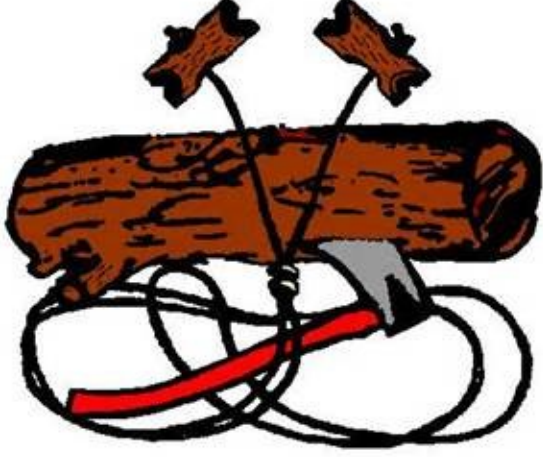


Who can attend Wood Badge?

Wood Badge is for all leaders (Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Venture, Varsity Team, Council, District, and Youth Leaders over 18) in the Boy Scouts of America. The course content and leadership principles introduced apply to all leadership positions and will provide a common foundation of leadership skills to be used throughout all programs.



Qualifications

- ◆ Each participant in Wood Badge training must be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.
- ◆ Have completed basic training courses for their Scouting Position.
- ◆ Complete the Annual Health and Medical Record form available at www.scouting.org
- ◆ Submit registration (on-line or paper) and all fees by July 12, 2018 to Hoosier Trails Council.

Objectives of Wood Badge

Wood Badge accomplishes these goals by building all the pieces of the course on a foundation of five central themes. These themes, and the presentations that directly support them, are as follows:

- ◆ **Living the Values.** *Values, Mission, and Vision*
- ◆ **Bringing the Vision to Life:** *Listening to Learn; Communication; Leveraging Diversity Through Inclusiveness; Generations in Scouting; Coaching and Mentoring*
- ◆ **Models for Success.** *Stages of Team Development; Leading EDGE/ Teaching EDGE*
- ◆ **Tools of the Trade.** *Project Planning; Leading Change; Decision Making and Problem Solving; Managing Conflicts; Self-Assessment*
- ◆ **Leading to Make a Difference.** *Servant*
