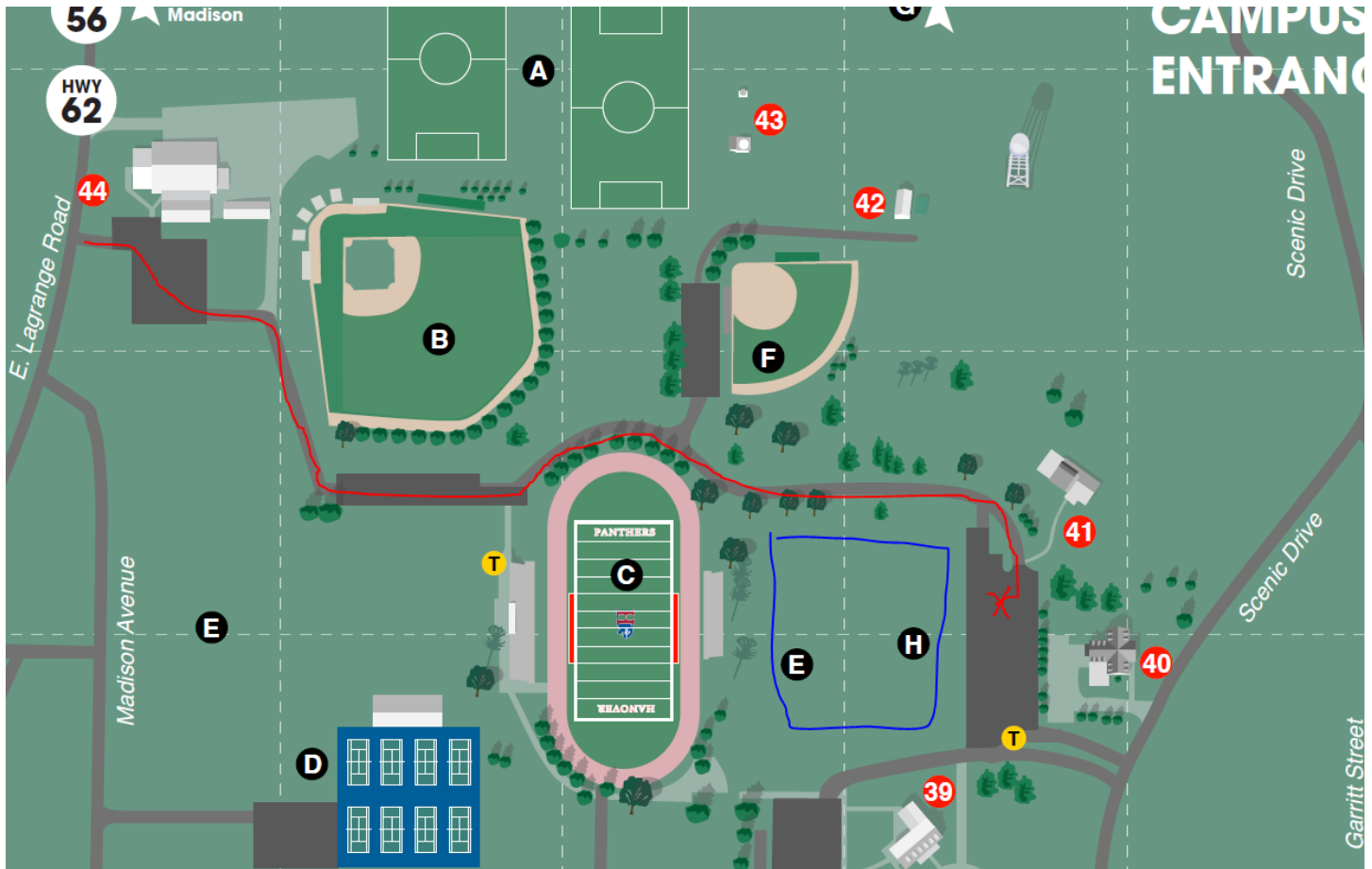


Accept the Challenge at the Hoosier Hills District's Winter Camporee...

The 2018 Hanover Winter Games

LOCATION

Hanover College in Hanover, Indiana. Just off State Road 56. Registration and check in will take place in *The Shoebox*, marked on the campus map with a number 41. Camping will be in the field just west of *The Shoebox*.



CAMPOREE FEES

Youth and Adult Early Registration Fee

\$20 (if paid by February 16)

This includes a patch, all activities and events, and dinner on Saturday.

Youth and Adult Late Registration Fee

\$25 (if paid after February 16)

This includes a patch subject to availability, all activities and events, and dinner on Saturday.

Cub Scout Day Youth Participant Registration Fee

\$10 (if paid by February 16)

This includes a patch and all Saturday activities and events. Accompanying adults and leaders are not charged a fee, but any participating siblings must register along with the Cub Scout.

Cub Scout Day Additional Dinner Fee

\$10 (must pay by February 16)

Any Cub Scout Day participant, parent, or other that wishes to stay for dinner is subject to a \$10 meal fee.

MORE INFORMATION

Meals are not provided for breakfast or lunch. Saturday's dinner is part of your registration fee. Cub Scout folks that wish to stay for Saturday night's dinner are welcome to register for the meal.

Fires will be allowed only with the use of a fire pan or tray. No ground fires are permitted. All lit fires must be attended and have a water bucket nearby.

Volunteer opportunities will be posted at check-in. All units should plan to volunteer in some capacity.

EMS and Security services will be onsite, covered by campus officers. A building will be open at all times for any participant that needs to come inside and warm up.

SO, WHAT ARE THE WINTER GAMES?

The Winter Games are an awesome way to challenge yourself and others in series of activities, skill-testing, and experiences during the Winter Camporee. Teams will be patrol style and made of no less than six and no more than ten youth. Teams can register to participate on Friday at check-in. Bronze, Silver, and Gold winners will be announced during an awards ceremony at the Saturday Evening Campfire. Points can be earned for winning competitions, attending different program areas, completing different activities, and demonstrating skills. The Winter Games can include anything from orienteering, knots, first aid, nature study, hiking, and more! Be prepared to show off those Scout skills!

Cub Scouts will have the opportunity to participate in a version of the Winter Games and access to many of the same activities throughout the day!
