On Saturday, February 24, 2018, Lenni Lenape District is hosting a Merit Badge Day at Jennings County Middle School, North Vernon. Cost is \$5 per Scout and Adult to cover patch, school staff, and insurance cost. **PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN LUNCH**, lunch *WILL NOT BE PROVIDED*. Scoutmasters, please have the scouts Blue Cards filled out with their information before you come on Saturday, and with the Scoutmaster's signature. **There will be no walk-ins allowed on this date.**

The goal is to try and complete the merit badges on this day, but many of the merit badges have prerequisites that the scout needs to bring signed off, evidence from their parents and/ or scoutmaster, or need to bring in the work. Below are the Merit Badges to be done, and Prerequisites: **Scouts please read Merit Badge Book and requirements** (either in the "Boy Scout REQUIREMENTS 2017" book or at **www.meritbadge.com**) don't forget, many of these merit badges want you to discuss with your counselor, so be ready to do that too!!

Go to Hoosier Trails Council web site click on calendar. Look for it on the month of February- <http://www.hoosiertrailsbsa.org> . Please note there is pre pay, \$7 if paid by February 10, 2018 to guarantee your class spot and a patch. Paid after that date it will be \$9 and no patch. Send payment to: Lenni Lenape Merit Badge Day, Hoosier Trails Council, 5625 E State Road 46, Bloomington, IN 47401. **Must have payment paid to Council office before deadline date, if received after by mail or phone late fees will apply. All persons coming to event must pay fee. Units must meet the two deep leadership there.*******

All classes will be limit of 20 unless noted. **We are limiting Troops to only 4 scouts per session.** This way all Troops should have a chance of taking the class.

You will be able to add and remove scouts as needed when registering, don't pay until you have completed all your registrations. Site will be locked out on deadline date of **February 22, 2018**. I will be sending updates and school map to contact persons as date gets closer. The person doing the online registration will be getting the maps and classroom numbers, please make sure that is done by an adult leader, there may be additional communication done about classes thru that email. Also after registration is complete please send email with Unit Number, Contact person, number of scouts and adults registered. Each time you add or remove scout please advise Jeff for his records.

Scouts please read the merit badge book for all merit badges you sign up to take.

Chess No prerequisites. Please bring a chess set if you have one. One sessions at 9- 11:55am. Counselor will be Robert McGaughey.

Citizenship in the Community Prerequisites are 2(bring a map of your hometown), (3a,b) ,(4a,b,c) ,(7a,b,c). 2 sessions at 9-11:55 and 1:00-3:55. Counselor will be Michele Seim

Citizenship in the Nation Reqs # 2 and # 3; # 6 be ready to discuss a famous speech; # 8 bring in email evidence and if possible response from your senator or congressman. 2 sessions at 9- 11:55 and 1:00-3:55. Counselor will be

Citizenship in the World Bring & be ready to discuss Req 3 and choose one of the following 7a, b, d, or e signed by parent/scoutmaster. There is a lot of discussion to cover so be prepared. 2 sessions at 9- 11:55 and 1:00-3:55. Counselor will be Dave Baldwin.

Coin Collecting Bring in samples of your collection for # 6, # 7, # 9 (9d would be the easiest) and # 10 (They can take the virtual tour at www.usmint.gov. & have parents send a note) 2 Sessions at 10:30-11:55 and 2:30-3:55.

Collections Bring in sample of your collection(s). Have # 1 completed. Req 5a, d, e should be written down and brought to class. Req 8 do the research and write it down. Be prepared to discuss your collection. There will be 2 sessions of this merit badge 9:00-10:25 and 1:00-2:25. Class size is 15 scouts. Counselor will be Kay Barwick.

Communications The Class will be doing requirement 1. C. In a small-group setting, meet with other scouts or with friends. Have them share personal stories about significant events in their lives that affected them in some way. Take note of how each scout participates in the group discussion and how effectively he communicates his story. Report what you have learned to your counselor about the differences you observed in effective communication.

Be prepared to do ONE of the following in Class:

2. A Think of a creative way to describe yourself, using, for example, a collage, short story or autobiography, drawing or series of photographs, or a song or skit. Using the aid you created, make a presentation to your counselor about yourself.

-OR-

2. B Choose a concept, product, or service in which you have great confidence. Build a sales plan based on its good points. Try to persuade the counselor to agree with, use, or buy your concept, product or service. After your sales talk, discuss with your counselor how persuasive you were.

Be prepared to deliver requirement: 3. Write a five-minute speech and give it at a meeting of a group.

The Class will be doing requirement: 4. Interview someone you know fairly well, like, or respect because of his or her position, talent, career or life experiences. Listen actively to learn as much as you can about the person. Then prepare and deliver to your counselor an introduction of the person as though this person were to be a guest speaker, and include reasons why the audience would want to hear this person speak. Show how you would call to invite this person to speak.

(Attend meeting before attending merit badge class (signature from scout master verifying attendance, for signoff in class) or after.)

5. Attend a public meeting (city council, school board, debate) approved by your counselor where several points of view are given on a single issue. Practice active listening skills and take careful notes of each point of view. Prepare an objective report that includes all points of view that were expressed, and share this with your counselor.

The Class will be doing requirement: 6. with your counselor's approval, develop a plan to teach a skill or inform someone about something. Prepare teaching aids for your plan. Carry out your plan. With your counselor, determine whether the person has learned what you intended.

Do **ONE** of the following before attending merit badge class (signature from scout master verifying for signoff in class) or after.

7. A Write to the editor of a magazine or your local newspaper to express your opinion or share information on any subject you choose. Send your message by fax, email or regular mail.

7. B Create a web page or blog of special interest to you (for instance, your troop or crew, a hobby, or a sport).. Include at least three articles or entries and one photograph or illustration, and one link to some other Web page or blog that would be helpful to someone who visits the Web page or blog you have created. It is not necessary to post your Web page or blog to the Internet, but if you decide to do so, you must first share it with your parents and counselor and get their permission.

7. C Use desktop publishing to produce a newsletter, brochure, flier or other printed material for your scout troop, class at school, or other group. Include at least one article and one photograph or illustration.

Req. 8: (We will develop a campfire program but the scout will need to serve as master of ceremonies later or the scout can do all of this before the class, if they perform this before MB day, the scoutmaster will need to sign that box on the blue card or send proof that it has been completed) Plan a troop or crew court of honor, campfire program, or an interfaith worship service. Have the patrol leaders' council approve it, then write the script and prepare the program. Serve as master of ceremonies.

The Class will be doing requirement: 9. Find out about three career opportunities in the field of communication. Pick one and find out the education, training, and experience required for this profession. Discuss this with your counselor, and explain why this profession might interest you. Class size is 15 scouts. 1 session from 1:00-3:55. Counselor will be Robert McGaughey.

Disabilities Awareness Prerequisites are 2 and 5a, b, or c. 2 sessions at 9:00-11:55 and 1:00-3:55.

Emergency Preparedness Prerequisites 1(earn first aid merit badge), 2b, 7a & 7b, 8b, scouts choice from #9. Class size will be 15 scouts. 1 session at 9:00-11:55. Counselor will be Kathy Dayhoff-Dwyer

Engineering Write down and bring in information for #6b on electric use at home. Do #7 and be prepared to discuss. 2 sessions at 9:00-11:55 and 1:00-3:55. Class size 12 per class.

Environmental Science Prerequisites: 3E & 4A. 2 sessions at 9:00-11:55 and 1:00-3:55. Counselor will be Eric Likens.

Fire Safety Prerequisites: 6a safety survey, fire-escape plan, fire drill schedule, conduct drill. Req 12 research a career and be ready to discuss. One all-day session. Class size will be 10 scouts.

First Aid There will be one all day session. Class size is 20. Prerequisites are 1, and 2d(home first aid kit). Counselor will be Jenna Behrman

Genealogy Req. 2, 4b, 5 must be completed before Merit Badge day. Class size will be 10 scouts. 2 sessions at 9:00-11:55 and 1:00-3:55
Counselor will be Darra Moore.

Personal Management Prerequisites are 1, 2A, and 10 bring in to discuss. 2 sessions 9:00-11:55 and 1:00-3:55. Class size 15 per session.

Photography Prerequisites are 4, 5, be ready to discuss 8. 2 sessions 9:00-11:55 and 1:00-3:55. Counselor will be Jim Adkins

Public Speaking Be prepared to do some speeches with visual aids for #2. Prepare ahead of time #4, and # 1. 4 sessions at 9:00-10:25
10:30-11:55, 1:00-2:25 and 2:30-3:55. Class size is 5 scouts. Counselor will be Steve Stanton.

Stamp Collecting Bring validation of # 7 (do TWO) and #8 (do ONE). Prepare to discuss / demonstrate #1 through #6 in class. 1 session at 9:00-
11:55. Counselor will be Paula Sandlin.

Shoot! NOVA Award *This is a NOVA Award, not a Merit Badge prerequisites:

1. Research projectile motion, aviation, weather, astronomy, or space technology topics by watching videos and/or reading for three hours.
2. Bring at least 2 questions from each source to discuss on Merit Badge Day with the counselors.
3. Earn one of the following merit badges previously to Merit Badge Day: Archery, Astronomy, Athletics, Aviation, Game Design, Rifle Shooting, Robotics, Shotgun Shooting, Space Exploration, Sustainability, or Weather.
4. Be prepared to discuss how the merit badge uses science with the counselors on Merit Badge Day.

All other requirements for the Shoot! Nova Award will be completed during Merit Badge Day. This will include catapults, marble roller coasters, satellite progression, and more! A card (similar to a blue card) will be given to each Scout showing his progress.
