- ◆ **Tools of the Trade.** *Project Planning; Leading Change; Decision Making and Problem Solving; Managing Conflicts; Self-Assessment*
- ◆ **Leading to Make a Difference.** *Servant Leadership; Leaving a Legacy*

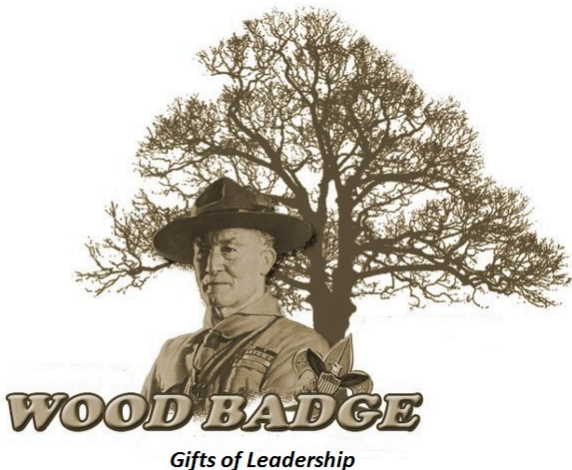

## Who can attend Wood Badge?

Wood Badge is for all leaders (Cub Scout, Scouting BSA, Venture, Varsity Team, Council, District, and Youth Leaders over 18) in the Boy Scouts of America. The course content and leadership principles introduced apply to all leadership positions and will provide a common foundation of leadership skills to be used throughout all programs.

- ◆ Each participant in Wood Badge training must be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.
- ◆ Have completed basic training courses for their Scouting Position.
- ◆ Complete the Annual Health and Medical Record form available at [www.scouting.org](http://www.scouting.org)
- ◆ Submit registration (online or paper) with deposit and pay all fees in full by July 26, 2019 to Hoosier Trails Council.

Although the course is different today than it was 100 years ago, what Baden-Powell said in 1919 still applies:

*"One of the purposes of Wood Badge training is to get Scouters to think about the practice of Scouting, to meet together, to exchange experiences, and to live together in the spirit of the Scout Oath."*
