

EVENT Update – 1/9/2022

Good afternoon Scoutmasters and Cubmasters!

We got several updates for everyone.

1. As of today (Jan 9th) we are a go for the Winter Rendezvous on the 21st of this month.
2. We have nearly 200 people and 13 different troops signed up so far.
3. January 16th will be the last day to register (no exceptions). There will be no walk-in registration because of food costs.
4. We are extending the early bird registration fees until Jan 16th. Registration is here <https://scoutingevent.com/145-49654>
5. We are adding a cooking demonstration area for the cub scouts up at the dining hall.
6. Cub Scouts will be doing their own Klondike at Osage and have an opportunity to do the following age appropriate activities: AOLS: Firebuild, Snowshoe race, period dress, cooking competition, and BBs. All Cubs: Snowshoe race, period dress, cooking competition, and BBs. Cub Parents who plan to be out there with their cubs must register for the event if they want to eat at the Feast.
7. We are adding back the Cooking Competition for all (youth and adult) to participate.
8. Food: The Feast and Saturday Cracker Barrell will be outside this year. We will provide those details at the Friday night leaders meeting. This should significantly decrease your unit food budget.... Yay!
9. Masks: Buildings will only be used as necessary and masks will be required. Outdoor mask usage will be up to each unit.
10. If your unit ends up with COVID I am asking for you to please notify me immediately that your unit cannot come due to COVID. Remember, we will not be checking temps at the gate. You as the adult leaders must do that prior to leaving for camp and have all those health forms filled out stating that you have done all that. Check-in will be at the administration office (scoutmaster & SPL and cubmasters) as the first thing you do prior to leaving the parking lot. Please go there for campsite assignments.

We are closely monitoring the COVID situation as it continues to happen. If something changes, we will immediately send out updating news of any additional steps or plans of action, to all those who have registered.
