	 Wear Work Clothes Friday night You will need your uniform for Saturday night, but do not wear it to registration. You will sleep in the clothes you arrive in on Friday and complete your cheerful service in them on Saturday. Clothes can be Scout related or any other clothing that is comfortable to work in that you don't mind getting dirty. We recommend an old T-Shirt, long pants, long sleeved shirt, rugged shoes and socks, and a hat.
