

Packing List for Your Ordeal

- □ Wear Work Clothes Friday night
 - o You will need your uniform for Saturday night, but do not need to wear it to registration.
 - o You will sleep in the clothes you arrive in on Friday and complete your cheerful service in them on Saturday.
 - o Clothes can be Scout related or any other clothing that is comfortable to work in that you don't mind getting dirty. We recommend an old T-Shirt, long pants, jacket, rugged shoes and socks, and a hat.

You will not be allowed to take anything else with you on your Ordeal. During your ordeal, you will be under a vow of silence and spend a night under the stars. Eat heartily before you come, as food will be scant until the feast on Saturday evening. You will spend Saturday doing various cheerful service for the camp, and after service is completed, you will take a shower and change into your full Field Uniform (Class A).
