Preparations

In accordance with the BSA Motto “Be Prepared” we ask that all packs/troops/units be prepared for weather, environment, and bring all of their ten or six essentials. This event will take place within the main camp at CCLT. Some additional items that may be needed are, compass, GPS device, 8x8 tarp, pan w/ lid, notebook, pencil.

We are excited to have everyone that wants to enjoy the fun and excitement attend. Registration is open NOW please register sooner rather than later to make sure we have all needed materials and supplies for everyone! We are excited to have everyone attend please brief ALL your scouts on the importance of scout spirit before attending as this will be a piece of their score for each station (ex. Permission to enter, chant, flag,...etc.) Scouts will not be asked for these items but simply need to complete them at their stations for a score!

Meals

ALL TROOPS/PACKS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN MEALS.

Cooking Competition

Packs will make a main course dish, troop **YOUTH** will make a dessert completed on Saturday evening. The meal/dessert must be brought to the dining hall porch by pack adults and youth and troop youth between **6:00 and 6:30PM any meal there after 6:30 will NOT be judged.** Meals/desserts will be judged on the components of these items (taste, smell, looks, texture, and presentation). Again, any food not brought by the above time will not be eligible for judging.

First aid/emergency info

There will be a health officer stationed in the admin building. If a health related situation arises, find an event staff member ASAP and they will contact the health officer.

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Check-In/Out Information:

Each unit needs to CHECK IN AND CHECK OUT in the admin building so we know which units to account for!

- Immediately upon arrival. At check-in, the SPL and Scoutmaster will receive any additional info and materials, and (if staying overnight) will be assigned a campsite.

Only the troop/pack trailer and the vehicle towing it allowed in camp

Friday

ALL UNITS MUST CHECK IN! Check in at admin upon arrival to be assigned a campsite and get information. ONLY GO TO THE SITE YOU ARE ASSIGNED! We ask units to go to their assigned areas due to station locations. There will be a cracker barrel and we ask that units coming on Friday bring something to share with everyone.

Check in will be 6pm-8pm

Saturday

ALL UNITS MUST CHECK IN EVEN IF NOT SPENDING THE NIGHT!!!

Check in will be 7:30-8:00 am

If units do not arrive by this time they will miss stations that will not be made up later which will result in a loss of points.

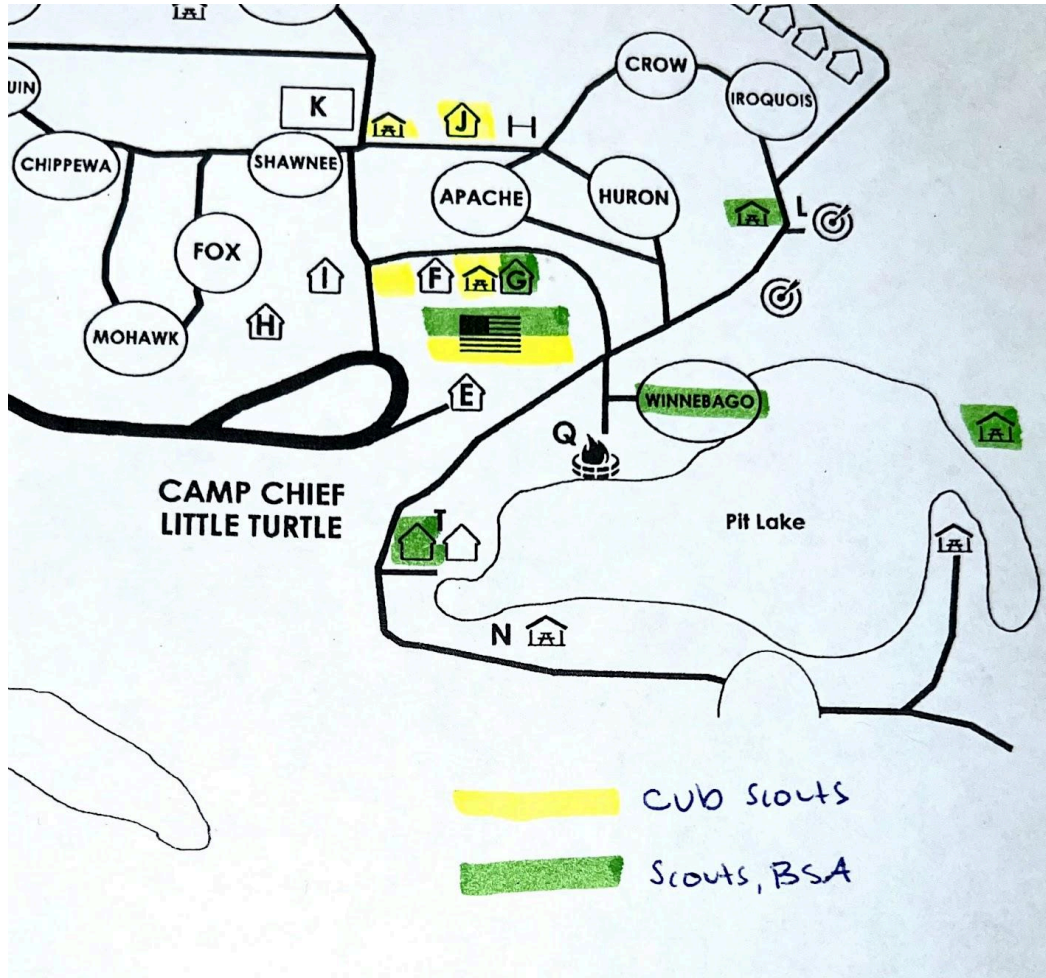

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[Scouts, BSA Station Explanation](#)

Scouts will be given a numbered envelope that is assigned at registration. This is the number that is expected to be used the entire day. The envelopes will have clues, time of next station, destination clues, and elimination of suspects. Scouts will also be given special announcements like lunch, dinner, and other locations that they need to be throughout the day. The whole day the stations are set up as rooms from a CLUE board along with characters. At each station the volunteer will inform the scouts of their name and explain what is expected of them at each station. Scouts should have the needed materials, if they do not and they have to borrow this will result in loss of points. They will also lose points if they are late to their station or do not complete their station. **Adults ARE NOT to be walking around with the scouts.** *Leaders should be running a station or asking a staff member for a task if they do not have anything to do.* The goal by the end of the day is to have it narrowed down to one suspect by the time campfire arrives so the scouts can identify who did the crime. If you need a staff member please look for someone with a walkie talkie and they will be able to help you! If a group finishes their station early they are welcome to do what they please, however the start time is a set time and station leaders will be ready to start at that time, **DO NOT BE LATE!**

We hope you have a great time at this event and be on the lookout for extra clues!
