Camping

For those camping, there will be assigned areas. When checking in you will be given an assigned number. Please follow the assigned number. Trailers are allowed in the camping area, however, if the ground is frozen, trailers will be in near vicinity to the camping area. If you are staying overnight and will be there on Sunday, we encourage everyone to join us for a Scout's Own Service. There are portapotties at this location along with flushing toilets located inside the cabin. Water is only located in the cabin and at a well.

Stations

Check-In & Check Out

Check-In

Check-in will be located in the cabin. When checking in a leader (Scouts, BSA & Cubs) is needed along with SPL (Scouts, BSA). All units MUST be checked in before they can start setting up their camping location or participating in activities! When leaders check in they will be given a packet of detailed information regarding information they need to know for this event. Both parts A&B of the health form must be filled out and turned in to attend the event (adults and youth). Wristbands will be given to scouts once they have checked in. IF you are not wearing a wrist band you will be sent back to check in, the wristband MUST be worn the entire time of the event.

Check-Out

If individuals are leaving they need to inform their unit leader before leaving.
