Events:

Puffball External Ballistics Challenge: Scouts will design, build, and shoot puffballs towards a target.

Scout Escape Room: Scouts will use scouting knowledge and the Scout Law to solve the puzzle and escape the teepees.

Snapper Pond: Scouts will use staves and lashings to create a fishing pole to catch the elusive "snapper fish". This will be catch and release.

Survival Fire Building: Just like it sounds. Scouts build a fire - teepee style, log cabin style, etc. Timing and number of matches used will be part of the judging.

Galileo's Gold Rush: Troops would build their carts and bring them to the Camporee. Races to 100' pulling scouts and gear. This will be a timed event, fastest time wins. Wheels may be used if there is no snow. This is a study of velocity in order to reach the gold first. We plan to have some sleds if a troop does not have their own.

The Black Hole: Similar to frisbee golf - players will compete to throw a frisbee as close to the target (black hole) in the least # of attempts. Requires teamwork and problem-solving with varying wind, etc. There will be a line marking the event horizon, which will add bonus points if frisbee lands on it.

Fort Miami Bungee Jump: Scout's objective is to give Barbie the greatest thrill while still ensuring that she is safe. This means that she should come as close as possible to the ground without hitting the ground

STEM Study in Aerodynamics: Scouts will design, build, and test various flying contraptions like airplanes, loop planes, helicopters, etc.
