Stations

Lord of the Rings Orienteering:

Go on an adventure across
Middle Earth with your patrol
and show off your
pathfinding skills! Navigate
your fantasy journey through
the use of a compass.



<u>Scoring</u>: Patrols will be graded on time taken, completing the course in the correct order, and overall comfortability with orienteering.



Friday The Thirteenth Axe Throwing:

Description: Take aim and throw some axes at this spooky horrormovie themed station!

Scoring: The average of all eligible patrol member's scores (based on

accuracy) will be taken to determine points.

Superhero First Aid:

Description: Go on a scavenger hunt to respond to superheroes in distress! Test your skills with a stretcher race!

Scoring: Scouts will be graded



on their responses to first aid scenarios based on a checklist. Accurate assessment and treatment will result in more points, so come prepared with your super first aid knowledge!



How To Train Your Dragon Firebuilding:

Description: Who's fire will burn the highest? Compete with other patrols to show off your 'dragon breath' in a fire building contest!

<u>Scoring</u>: Patrols will be judged based on the amount of time it takes for their fire to burn through a wooden rod, and the amount of matches they use.

Rango Rifle Shooting:

Compete with other patrols at the range to be the best shot in the wild, wild West!

Scoring: The average of all eligible patrol member's scores (based on accuracy) will be taken to determine points.





Movie Trivia:

Put your knowledge of popular movies to the test at this jeopardystyle station where you will compete to see which patrol knows the most fun film facts!

<u>Scoring:</u> Points will be awarded for correct answers, with more

challenging questions being worth more points.

Castaway Pioneering:

Description: Use your knot tying skills to save Wilson the Volleyball! Make sure you know your two-half hitches!

Scoring: Patrols will be awarded points based on time taken to complete



challenges, as well as for completing bonus challenges!




The Hunger Games Gaga Ball:

Scoring: Patrols will be awarded points based on the success of their

overall patrol in several gaga ball games, as well as individuals.



Station Locations

Awards:

After a fun day of stations on Saturday, each station will select the patrol with the highest score as their winner! Second and third place will also be awarded.

First, second, and third place overall will also be awarded based on a patrol's total rankings across all eight stations!

The patrol with the best costumes will win the "Best Dressed" Award! Be sure to show up dressed as your favorite movie character, or any fun costume you want to show off!

The Campfire program will be from 8:00-9:00 PM. Troops are encouraged to submit a (scouting appropriate) skit or song for the program! Be sure to let SPLs from the hosting troops (133 and 1033) know if you want a spot in the campfire program. Good times to submit a skit or song would be at lunch or between stations.
