Individual awards:

ND	Monon Unit Impact Award	- One adult volunteer per unit will be recognized
✓	Scouter's Training Award	- Adult in a pack/troop/crew or the district who completes all requirements
✓	Scouter's Key	- Adult in a pack/troop/crew or the district who completes all requirements
✓	Unit Leader Award of Merit	- Cubmaster/Scoutmaster/Advisor nominated by unit committee & youth after qualifying
✗	Community Service Award	- Educators, American Legion members, etc. who qualify for special community service awards
✗	Adult Religious Emblem	- Religious emblems earned by qualification and selection within the leader's faith community
✓	James E West Fellowship	- Adult who donates at a threshold level to the local council endowment fund.
✓	Special Needs Scouting Award	- Adult who gives active & outstanding service to Scouts with disabilities or specials needs
✓	Commissioner Arrowhead	- Active unit/roundtable/district commissioner who completes all requirements
✓	Commissioner Key	- Active commissioner who previously earned Arrowhead & completes all requirements
✓	Commissioner Excellence	- Active unit/roundtable/district commissioner nominated for excellence in service
✓	New Unit Organizer	- Registered/trained leader who is a charter member of new unit and meets all requirements
✓	Veteran Award	- Adult who has actively participated in a registered youth or adult role for 5,10,15,20,25,>25 years
✓	Jerry Simon Award of Distinction	- Career Scouting recognition for tireless service to Scouting over at least twenty years
✓	District Award of Merit	- Highest BSA recognition awarded to a district volunteer; up to 1 award per 25 traditional units

Unit awards:

✓	Messengers of Peace	- Pack, troop, or crew that meets all requirements
✓	Historic Trails Award	- Pack, troop, or crew that meets all requirements
✓	National Outdoor Challenge Award	- Troop that meets all requirements
ND	Veteran Unit Award	- Traditional unit chartered for over 25 years, recognized thereafter in 5-year increments
