



WHITE RIVER DISTRICT AWARDS SUMMARY

Certificates of Appreciation are given for exemplary service to the youth in Scouting. It is usually awarded following at least a year's service to youth. **Maximum awarded annually: *Unlimited***

The Universal Emblem is given for continued service to youth of an ongoing and outstanding nature. Typically awarded after three years of service. **Maximum awarded annually: 20**

The Scout Statuette is awarded for helping your unit and/or the District present a quality program to make Scouting worthwhile and fun for the youth of Sakima District. Typically awarded after five years of service. **Maximum awarded annually: 10**

The White Hat Award is given to individuals who have performed special services to their unit and/or the District over the last year. It is given independent of

Family of the Year Award is presented to a family of registered Scouters that show exemplary service to the district. This family personifies the Scouting Spirit in their actions and daily lives. **Maximum awarded annually: 1**

Heart of Gold Award is presented to the spouse of a registered Scouter who has been active in Scouting for many years. This award recognizes the spouse's support, sacrifice, and encouragement during the Scouter's tenure. **Maximum awarded annually: 1**

The District Award of Merit is presented by the District to scouters who have shown exemplary service to the youth in our District for an extended period of time. **Maximum awarded annually: 3**

Eagles in Action is recognition for Eagle Scouts age 18 through 25 who are not just registered with a troop, but whom are active on a regular basis leading their units with noteworthy service. **Maximum awarded annually: 1**

The Silver Beaver is a Council award presented to scouters who have served both the youth in Scouting and their community above and beyond what can be reasonably expected. **Maximum awarded annually: *Council Controlled***
