

## **5<sup>th</sup> Annual Buffalo Stampede Information and Safety Guide**

Your participation in this cycling event supports scouting programs in North Central Indiana. Riders may launch at 7:00 a.m. for the 100 mile; 8:00 a.m. for the 63 mile; Mass launch at 10:00 a.m. for the 13, 28, 52, mile routes. SAG Stop opening and closing are based on the launch times faster riders may launch later but we ask that you please launch no later than 1 hour after your scheduled launch time. All riders should plan on being off the course by 5:00 p.m. Please check back in when you return.

**After the ride, please enjoy the post ride meal at Camp Buffalo by checkin/out.**

- **YOU WILL BE RIDING ON IN HWY 119 FOR SHORT DISTANCES – PLEASE BE AWARE OF AUTOMOBILE TRAFFIC**

- **ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR A HELMET.**
- **Please obey traffic laws. Stop at Stop Signs. Use hand signals when turning. Do not ride more than two abreast.**
- **Respect your fellow riders. Point out road hazards to them.**
- **When riding on the Panhandle Pathway and/ or the North Judson Erie Trail, respect other trail users. Pass on the left. Announce yourself when coming up from behind. Be cautious of the Balusters and Gates at the intersections.**
- **Your wristband corresponds to the color arrow you will follow for the Buffalo Head Dan Henry markers - Yellow = 100, Orange = 63, Blue = 52, Green = 28, Red = 13. Each turn is marked with a Dan Henry approximately 50 feet before the turn and at the turn. The correct route is marked 20 – 50 feet past the turn also. Intersections of paved roads continuing straight are marked too.
