



PURDUE UNIVERSITY Home of 100+ Merit Badges

- 3 Parking Garages (all have handicap parking spaces marked)
 - Northwestern Ave. Free All Day (PGSC on map)
 - University St. Free All Day (PGU on map)
 - Grant St., Paid, hourly parking rates are hourly (PGG on map)
 - \$3 for first 60 minutes and \$1 each hour for 2nd-8th hours; daily max \$10
 - Credit-card-only payment; must be made at a machine in the garage lobby before returning to your vehicle.
- If you are parking on campus all day, University St. is the best option followed by Northwestern Ave.
- If you have to leave and come back to campus, Northwestern will be your best option when you return. Christmas Show parking will occupy open spaces in University St. for their 12 PM and 4 PM shows.






Key Leadership for the event and those that are there to point you in the right direction will be in these light blue road vests!



A Frames/Sandwich Boards



- Regardless of where you park, head to ELLT: Elliott Hall of Music for check in and opening ceremony. There will be "A Frame" sandwich boards pointing you in the right direction along with volunteers in light blue event vests.
- You will enter in the Lower Lobby. Troops will check in, in the Lower Lobby (enter at the corner where these arrows are pointing.




Important App Notes

- Access is by email used to register for the event.






