BALOO Training is made up of two parts: an online course available on [My.Scouting.org](https://my.scouting.org), and an in-person, hands-on course. You must complete both parts to qualify as a trained outdoor Cub Scout leader.

The hands-on course involves camping overnight (after all, that's what the course is about – camping). You're going to learn a lot, from cooking to first aid to campfires to hiking and much, much more.

The **Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS)** course builds and expands on the concepts and themes introduced in Scoutmaster Position-Specific Training and provides Scouters with the confidence to take youth into the outdoors.

Specifically, this hands-on program gives adult leaders a practical introduction to the patrol method of a Scout-led troop by teaching many of the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Scouts in the outdoors. In addition, the teaching methods, activities, and games model the variety of teaching used in effective and engaging Scouting programs.
