1. Qualifications: Rank as of January 1, 2025

- a. If First Class or above, you may register for Eagle-required merit badge classes or other merit badge classes. Scouts must be Life Scout to register for Citizenship in Society merit badge.
- b. If Scout, Tenderfoot or Second Class, you may register for all merit badges except for any Eagle-required; you may also register to be in the Target First Class program, but you cannot register for both (must choose MBC or TFC).

2. Registration for merit badge classes

- a. From the list on KSU MBC Appendix 7, select your 1st through 6th choices for the AM or PM sessions.
- b. Enter the Merit Badge names for the merit badge in the table below.

3. Registration for Target First Class program: Enter your name and rank below and mark Target First Class. Scouts will need to bring a pencil, paper, a water bottle, and a compass. The activities will develop new scouting skills for some scouts; or will be a chance to review and improve skills for other scouts.

The registration fee for the Merit Badge Conference and for Target First Class is the same; \$45 (Monday, 2/17/25, 12:00 AM - Monday, 4/7/25, 11:59 PM) or \$60 (Tuesday, 4/8/25, 12:00 AM - Monday, 4/14/25, 11:59 PM) per Scout which includes lunch and a patch.
