General Instructions

Message

A camporee is a gathering of many scout troops. It brings troops within the district together to participate in events that they could not do individually. It also provides the opportunity to “display” your expertise or to “check-out” the competition. It is a great way to fellowship with other troops and to learn from other scouts. A camporee recognizes that a patrol is the basic (camping) unit. Therefore, we encourage troops make use of the patrol method. A camporee has events specifically designed for patrols to test their teamwork and scout skills. The theme for this year’s camporee is “*Search & Rescue*”

Troop Registration

Troops may register for the Camporee online at www.coronadocouncil.org. Payment with a credit card, debit card, or Electronic Check is required for online registration. Cost for the Camporee will be **\$10.00 for youth and \$5.00 for adults**. Early Bird Registration is \$10 per person before September 3rd and registration is \$15 from September 4th-17th. Each registered scout and adult will receive a 2018 Camporee Patch. Webelos that want to attend **MUST** be registered to tag along with a troop and must have a parent or guardian with them. Everyone in attendance **MUST** complete the “Assumption of Risk” form which can be downloaded at registration or can be found at the end of this leader’s guide.

Check-In and Check-Out Procedures

Check-in will begin at 6:30 PM on Friday evening. Troops are asked to check-in no later than 9:00 PM. Please have a roster of scouts and adults that are attending. Please follow the posted signs. Parking will be available after bonfire Saturday night for Troops wishing to leave for Palm Sunday. The rest of the checkout will begin at 7:00 A.M. Sunday. Camporee patches are distributed at checkout. **Please leave only one car and one trailer in the parking lot and park the rest of the vehicles in other designated parking spots.**

Medical Forms and Assistance

Each Troop should have up to date medical forms for each Scout and Adult Leader in attendance. Forms will not be collected by the Camporee staff, but should be available in the case of a medical emergency.

Saturday Evening

Saturday evening will include a potluck dinner. There will be a Campfire that night. Please check the weather forecast and plan accordingly for this activity.

Meals

Troops will be required to provide their own meals for the weekend. No food will be provided by the Camporee staff. The Camporee will **NOT** have a trading post.

Must Brings

Please make sure every Scout has appropriate camping equipment, **rain gear, sturdy closed-toe shoes** and **class A uniform**.

Fires in Camp

All fires must be “**above ground fires**”; or in **approved fire ring at the park**.

Troops should have fire barrels or some other device to contain their wood fires.

For your safety, please abide by the following rules:

1. Fires may be built only in burn barrels within the campsites and must be attended at all times while burning.
2. When striking camp, properly dispose of ashes and burned wood. Likewise, surplus, unburned wood can be placed in nearby tree line away from the open area.
3. Liquid fuels are not to be used to start wood fires.
4. Charcoal is permitted for use in cooking fires. The use of starting fuel to ignite charcoal is prohibited except under strict adult supervision.
5. Stoves and lanterns using alternate fuels such as white gas, kerosene or propane are permitted only under adult supervision.
6. Stoves and lanterns using alternate fuels will not be operated inside of tents or other enclosed areas.
7. Fires and lighted stoves or lanterns will not be left unattended in the campsite.
8. All fire lays will be properly and safely prepared by insuring that all burnable material is cleared from the area within a 5-foot radius of the edge of a fire barrel.

Tree Cutting

1. Tree cutting on the property is prohibited.
2. Use wood that is brought in or deadfall for wood that has been gathered to burn.

Water

Water will be available on site.

Assumption of Risk, Release, and Indemnity Agreement

Assumption of Risk: I understand that the activities in which I (or my child) will engage at or near Crisis City located at 6401 West M60 Road, Smolan, Kansas, involve inherent and other risks. I acknowledge that activities are strenuous and dangerous and require a certain degree of physical condition, ability, maturity, and skill. I acknowledge that I am solely responsible for determining my (or my child's) suitability to participate in the activities. I have (or my child) has the requisite skills, qualifications, physical and mental ability, and training necessary to properly and safely participate in the activities. I (or my child) share(s) responsibility for my safety and will follow instructions, make reasonable decisions, and act responsibly. Crisis City cannot ensure my (or my child's) safety and does not seek to eliminate all of the risks of the activities because they contribute to the training/exercise value. **I assume all inherent and other risks and accept responsibility for any property damage and loss, and for any personal injury, illness, disability, emotional distress, and death that I (or my child) may suffer, whether described above or not.**

In consideration of utilizing Crisis City venues and participating in events held at Crisis City, and allowing me (or my child) to participate in or observe activities, I agree to the following:

Waiver and Release: I (and behalf of my child) agree to forever release and discharge Crisis City, the State of Kansas, the Adjutant General's Department and all its employees from and agree not to sue for any and all liability or claims I (or my child) may have for any property damage and loss, personal injury, emotional distress, illness, disability, and death related to my (or my child's) participation in the activities or use of any equipment or facilities. This release is for any type of claim, including breach of contract, fraud, or any other type of suit and includes losses alleged to be caused by the negligence of Crisis City to the fullest extent permitted by law but does not include claims for gross negligence.

Indemnity: I agree to defend, indemnify (meaning to pay or reimburse any amount required to be paid, including attorney fees) and hold Crisis City, the State of Kansas, the Kansas Adjutant General's Department and all its employees, harmless from all claims, causes of action, liability, losses, or damages for any property damage, personal loss or theft, personal injury, disability, death or other loss brought by or on behalf of me, my child, a family member, my estate, another participant or spectator, or any other person arising from or relating to my (or my child's) use of property, facilities, and/or participation in the activities including claims that Crisis City was negligent.

Acknowledgment of Policies and Photo Waiver: I acknowledge reading and Understanding the Crisis City rules and regulations relating to the activities, facilities of Crisis City, and equipment and I agree to comply with and abide by those rules and regulations. Crisis City staff may take and use photographs, video, film and other images of me (or my child) participating in or observing

the activities. I waive any right of privacy, publicity, compensation, copyright or other rights to those images and I consent to Crisis City using those images for any purpose.

I have read this agreement, I understand its contents and I sign it voluntarily. I

intend by the Agreement to assume all hazards and risks, waive all rights to sue and release all liabilities and claims, and indemnify Crisis City, the state of Kansas, and the Adjutant General's Department and all of its employees, for any claims arising from my (or my child's) participate in the activities. I understand that this Agreement has no expiration date and remains in effect at all times that I am (or my child is) observing or participating in the activities and will be binding on me, my family members, my heirs, assigns, executors, representatives, and estates.
