- ◇ 2020 Would have been their 3rd year at camp.
- ◇ Earn the rank of Star scout prior to the event.
- ◇ Have completed the 7th grade.
- ◇ Brave recommendation form turned in.
- ◇ Foxman Questionnaire for naming
- ◇ Exceptions will be considered .Please explain on form.
- ◇ Scoutmasters will be notified by July 24th of acceptance or denial in to the tribe by email.

**Adult Foxman**

Adult foxman candidates will be called out on Friday night. To be eligible to be called out as a foxman candidate the following must be met:

- ◇ Must be at the Council ring prior to the callout.
- ◇ 2020 Would have been their 2nd year at camp.
- ◇ Completed the Gray Fox Check sheet. Given at camp last year.
- ◇ Grey Fox Questionnaire
- ◇ Adult warrior nomination form
- ◇ Foxman Questionnaire for naming

**Warriors and Your Men of Paint**

- ◇ Earn the proper scout rank prior to the event
- ◇ Turn in advancement form on time
- ◇ Have proper regalia prior to supper
- ◇ Attend dance practice
- ◇ Work your paint station at the event

### **Keeper of the Plains**

The Keeper of the Plains is the highest recognition honor that the Tribe of Golden Eagle can bestow on one of its members.

#### **SELECTION**

\*Any tribesman of Golden Eagle in good standing is eligible to receive this award regardless of tenure, rank or paint status.

\*The Keeper of the Plains recipients, at their discretion, may annually present this recognition to one adult member and one youth member of the Tribe of Golden Eagle.

\*The Keeper of the Plains recipients determines the process for deciding who will receive this award.

\*The committee should make their selection at the annual meeting of the Council of Keepers. Their decision is kept secret until the ceremony of presentation.

\*While limited to two awards each year, the Keeper of the Plains recipients may decide not to present a Keeper of the Plains.

\*Anyone may make a nomination for Keeper of the Plains by giving a nomination to a member of the award selection committee or the Directing Medicine Man. The Keeper of the Plains recipients may choose from nominated tribesmen or make their own nominations and selection.

\*The award is presented in recognition of outstanding contributions to Golden Eagle, Camp Hansen, and in the promotion of Coronado Area Council summer camping opportunities.

\*Holders of the "Keeper of the Plains" award will meet at a time and place determined by the Committee of Keeper's to determine appropriateness of awarding the "Keeper" to a member of the Council of Chieftains. Chieftains selected do not count against the yearly quota. Presentation of the "Keeper" to a Chieftain may occur during the weekly ceremonies during camp.
