



Wild Wild West Day Camp 2023

- What is it?** Metro Day Camp is a fun-filled, 3-day camp for Cub Scouts of ALL ages! Each day will provide the opportunity for your Scouts to have new experiences, with memories that will last a lifetime.
- When?** **Wednesday/Thursday/Friday July 19/20/21, 2023.** Registration starts at 8:30am. Opening Flag at 9:00am. Events run 9:15am to 4:
- Where?** OJ Watson Park, 3022 S McLean Blvd, Wichita, KS 67217. Check-in will begin at 8:30am each day of camp. Camp runs until 4:00pm each day. **If it is raining or thundering, we will continue with camp in a building to house us out of the weather**
- Activities?** All activities are age appropriate and based on program level, including shooting sports, arts & crafts, games, song, etc. Each person will need to pack a sack lunch each day.
- Supervision?** All Packs **MUST** have an adult! Scout ratio of 1/5 and be 2 deep in leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines and ALL adults must have completed Youth Protection Training prior to camp. Please provide a copy of all Adult Youth Protection Cards at check in the 1st day. ALL Tiger's must have parent partner with them. **NO Tag Along's! (LITTLE BROTHERS AND SISTERS)**
- Registration?** **Pre-registration is required** for us to provide program materials to all participants. Event is open to all scouts – Tiger thru Arrow of Light Scouts for all packs, in or out of Council. Registration is due May 26th.
Registration prior to April 14th will be \$50.00 per youth and \$20.00 per adult.
Registrations received April 14th – May 26th will be \$60.00/ youth and \$25.00/adult.
Registrations received May 27th – June 19th will be \$75/ youth and \$30/adult.
NO registrations will be accepted at After June 19th, or at Camp! Staff Registration = \$10.00
- Fees?** Registration is online only! **The registration can be found at <http://quivira.org/camping-with-quivira/> webpage. Once on ***Black Pug**, scroll the calendar of current events to find the Day Camp you wish to register for. Online payment is required and can be made by credit card or electronic check.**
- Health Forms?** Parts A & B of the health forms **MUST** be provided for all participants at check in. We will NOT have health forms to provide on-site. Any person without completed health form will not be allowed to take part in the event. Any persons not registered for the event will not be allowed to attend the event and will be asked to leave.
All adults attending must have taken Youth Protection Training.
- Refunds?** **There will be NO Refunds available, but you can transfer to another Scout.**
- Insurance?** Liability, as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance is provided for all registered youth and adult members of the Quivira Council.
