

# WEBELOS WOODS 2024

- What is it?** Webelos Woods serves as a stepping stone for Webelos (4th Grade) and Arrow of Light (5th grade) scouts. Hosted by Scouts BSA Troop 162.
- Activities?** On Saturday, Scouts will learn about First Aid, Cub Scout Basic Essentials, how to choose a campsite, technology while camping, hiking through nature, and more! Scouts and their adults will participate on a hike through Mandan Scout Camp so "Be Prepared" with proper clothing and footwear!
- When & Where?** Friday, September 27th at 7pm (for those that want to camp out Friday) through Sunday, September 29th at Mandan Scout camp. (11639 Garnett Road, Wright, KS - just north of Dodge City.)  
Check-in on Saturday begins at 9am! Bring your Medical forms A & B. (Required for ALL attendees, including adults).
- Supervision?** All units must have two-deep leadership and comply with Youth Protection guidelines. All adults in attendance shall have current Youth Protection training.
- Cost?** Early bird registration is \$35 per youth and \$20 per adult if paid in full by September 17th. Regular registration cost is \$40 per youth and \$25 per adult. Registration fee includes program supplies\* and Saturday lunch, dinner, and Sunday Breakfast.  
\*Cub Scout advancement pin.
- Refunds?** This is a rain or shine event. Refunds are not available, but fees may be transferred to another Scout or Adult under the same registration number.
- Registration?** This event is open to Webelos (4th grade) & AOL (5th grade) Scouts and their parent/guardian, or leader. Pre-registration is required in order for us to provide program materials to all participants. Register online through Black Pug at "www.quivira.org – Things to Do". Payments must be made online and can be by check or card. At check-in, units shall provide a current roster and BSA Medical Form A&B (for every youth and adult)
- Insurance?** Liability, Sickness, & Accident Insurance are provided for all registered BSA members of the Quivira Council.
