





What is it? This Quivira Council STEM Adventures Day will be located at Exploration Place in Wichita, and is an opportunity for Cub Scouts to get hands on experience doing a Science Elective.

Activities? The day consists of two, one-hour rotations of STEM activities appropriate to the ranks of each Cub Scout, one movie in the Dome Theater, one Live Science Show and an opportunity to interact with the Exhibits, allowing your Cub Scouts to complete all the requirements for the STEM Adventure Elective belt-loop for the Engineering thread and for rank advancement.
