BASIC INFO TO KNOW . . .

ScoutCon! is open to registered Scouts BSA, Ventures Scouts, Sea Scouts, and Registered BSA Adult Leaders. Note that BSA Adult Leaders must be current in YPT.

COSPLAY COSTUME CONTEST: No actual firearms allowed for this event. Weapons for cosplay must be clearly manufactured costume props and rated PG-13, represent a game/story lore.

TOURNAMENTS: everyone must demonstrate excellent sportsmanship, befitting a Scout, and win or lose gracefully.

Fees – NOTE the reduction in registration fees & NOTE the earlier dates:

- Early-bird Registration \$30.00 before October 12th (3 weeks prior to week of event)
- Regular Registration \$40.00 between October 12th and October 18th
- Late Registration \$50.00 between October 19th and October 25th
- Minions Registration \$25.00 - requires 4 hours of event service; capped at 35 minions (committee + 25 volunteers); sign up via Signup Genius;
- All event fees are due by October 25th, no exceptions. No registrations after October 25th or day of event registrations will be accepted.



BSA Health Form: BSA Health Form Parts A & B are required by ALL attending.

Dietary & Special Needs: Please complete the [Dietary Needs Request Form](#) and submit to **Kevin Gorman** no later than noon, Tuesday, October 27th.

Weather Conditions: ScoutCon is primarily an indoor activities event and will happen whether there is rain, shine, or snow. Please bring your own tent and be prepared for cold weather camping. **Be Prepared!** Think Trappers' Rendezvous conditions, but still bring short sleeves, just in case. If you are attending as an individual, please make sure you bring your own tent and other camping supplies. The Scout Field Uniform is not required; however, wearing them to and from the event is always good practice.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO KNOW: For 2023, Chautauqua County was in a Stage 3 Emergency Water Supply with limited water usage by all. We should plan for this contingency as it is a possibility in 2026. All units will be notified 2 weeks prior to the event if bringing water by troop is necessary.

NEW in 2023/2024/2025/2026: All games will be put up and cleared from the tables for meals. There will be NO Drinks or Food allowed on any table that has a game on it, even if it is your own game. No Exceptions. Also, a challenge card will be given to each Scout and Scouter, to engage in playing games with individuals from other units. Turn in your challenge card by 7pm on Saturday for the prize drawing.
