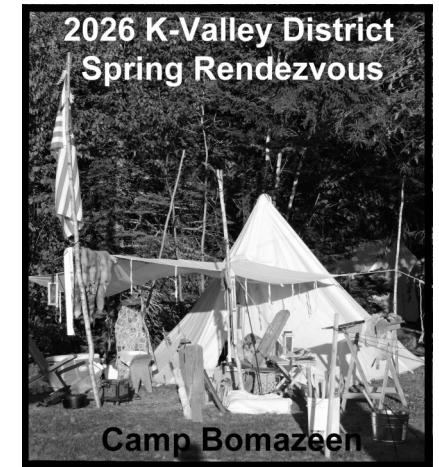

GENERAL INFORMATION

Location: Camp Bomazeen. 656 Horse Point Rd, Belgrade, ME 04917 Staff will then direct you to camping.

Campsites: Campsites will be assigned based on time you register and group size.

Firewood: Any downed trees can be used for firewood. Otherwise be prepared to supply your own wood.

Parking: Vehicles will need to be in designated parking lots unless required for medical reasons. You must confirm with staff.

Water: Portable water is available. Please bring containers

Patch Trading: Patch trading is encouraged. Bring your trading material. Please remember the scout law. Always remember to seal your trade with a handshake.

Blind Patch Trading: There will also be a Blind Patch Trading board. Adults and youth may participate. You will need 10 patches minimum to participate. These will be traded. Rules and details in the Leaders Guide.

TRADING POST: We will have a small trading post with patches and other stuff.

Trading blankets: Scouts will be encouraged to trade trade trade like in the time of the fur trade. See the leaders guide for trading rules and regulations. To participate you will need a red blanket and trading items.
