Wilderness First Aid (WFA) is the assessment of, and treatment given to an ill or injured person in a remote environment where definitive care by a physician and/or rapid transport is an hour or more away

Who should attend? Any unit leader whose Troop is planning a backcountry trek

Who can attend? Scout Leaders and Youth over the age of 14

Two sessions February 20th and March 6th 8am-4pm both days

Participants must attend both sessions and demonstrate skills learned to earn certification
