The afternoon Score Orienteering had superb results from many troops--well done!

Before dividing into the raw score above, the "# of p.m. pairs" above is adjusted to factor the % of older vs. younger, etc. Also the lowest score or two for larger troops is effectively dropped. (We encourage troops to bring as many scouts as possible.)

Ten or more scouts have long been required in order to win the top troop awards. Super Advanced & triples each count as a "pair". Troops with 18 or more youth had up to 16 additional Score O' markers (thus over the standard maximum "raw" score of 1064 (40 markers.)) "Route O' avg." includes points earned in Super Advanced.

° Taking Part: 40 units, 340 scouts* (all doing two or more O' courses) and 96 "participating adults" for a total of 436 orienteers. Twenty-two units camped at least one night. *Including 3 Civil Air Patrol youth (+10 adults). Excluding 2020, 340 is the least since 328 (Oct. 2000) and 300 (Dec. 1983). On Nov. 9, 1991, 841 scouts & 254 adults from 93 units orienteered; 1183 people were on site.

° This year, 18 different units had scouts in the Younger Top 23. That's a good sign, with that many troops' younger guys improving.

° Congrats to Troops 111 (and all the numerous troops that had some fine orienteering results this year!) For 111, they were troop champions for the seventh time (in a span of 20 years), breaking the record for the most ever, previously held by T. 340 from Lutherville which won six times from 1993 to 2000. Troop 111's 12 times in the top two is also a record. John Corso moved up from 2nd in Super Advanced last year and 9th in the younger category in 2017. On Score O', John navigated to an amazing 19 markers (a probable record 575 points for an individual or pair!) and wasn't alone, with 111's Older Category Champions Luke Zamoyta & Potter Hopfensperger getting 17 markers, five other 111 pairs getting 10 to 13 each including Younger Category Champions Brendan Kent and Ryan Parks. All pairs did well on Score Orienteering... a real team effort.

° Troop 439 was 2nd for the 2nd straight year, led by SPL Alex Johnson who with Mike Mueller got 11 Score O' markers and had a Top Five Older Category finish. It was a team effort (James Turk and Gabe Goodwin also found 11 markers.)

° Troop 102 and Girl Scout Troop 34012 combined and it sure worked out well, third place overall, everyone contributing, led by Edward Marine and Liam Lucas' 322 Score O' points and Top Eight finishes by James Casey-Kemp Timlen, Luke Salter-Emmett Omron (as in 2021, + 2018 for Luke), and Francesca Bader and Willa McMizkle in 8th.

° Troop 540 held onto fourth (they won this event in 2020) in the afternoon with Ian Martinson and James McKenna and also Aiden Thur and Jacob Quелlette each getting 12 or 13 Score O' markers.

° Zack Sheehey from 647 was in the top 3 for the 2nd straight year, 2nd-place Conner Jones in the Top Four for a 2nd time, and 647 has been in the Top Five for the last three competitions now.

° Kendall Kovarik was the first girl ever to complete the Super Advanced course, & did so in fine fashion. Since 1987 there have been 527 competitors over 36 years on the Super Advanced course.

° Liam Merrigan of 164 was in the Top Eight for a third time. Acting SPL Max Wang of 652 had his third Top Four finish since 2018.

° Troop 883 missed last year's Younger champion Sean Gugliotta & others down with the flu this year. Next year!
