The afternoon Score Orienteering had good results from many troops--well done!  
Before dividing into the raw score above, the # of p.m. pairs above is adjusted to factor the % of older vs. younger, etc. Also the lowest score(s) for larger troops is/ are effectively dropped. (We encourage troops to bring as many scouts as possible.)  
Ten or more scouts have long been required in order to win the top troop awards. Super Advanced & triples each count as a "pair". The five troops with 19 or more youth had 18 additional Score O' markers (thus 1554 possible points, not the standard maximum "raw" score of 1044 (36 markers.)) "Route O' avg." includes points earned in Super Advanced. Route O' results were so much better this year we didn't need to multiply troop Route O' scores (in order to make them very roughly worth half as much of troop Score O' scores.)

° Taking part: 52 units, 457 scouts\* (all doing two or more O' courses) and 154 "participating adults" for a total of 611 orienteers. Twenty-four units camped at least one night. \*including 4 Civil Air Patrol youth (+7 adults). This was our largest turnout since 2019. A total of **101 girls (22%, easily a record) and 356 boys orienteered.**

° This year, **15 different units had scouts in the Younger Top 25, and 14 different units in the Older Top 25...** Girls had a best-ever **11 of the top 50 spots (22%), including a first and a third.**

° Congrats to Troops **111** and **439**, #1 and #2 for the third straight year....and to the numerous troops that had some fine orienteering results this year! For **111**, they were troop champions for a record eighth time (in a span of 21 years). Troop **111**'s 13 times in the top two is also a record, as is their 6 of the top 8 in the younger category. The 101 girls present included GS-SOS's five award-earning teams (top 25 of each category) plus Kendall in the Super-Advanced where Hayden Burnside was in the Top Two for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year in a row. Connor Low had a 2<sup>nd</sup> Top Five finish and Zach Sheehey was in the Top Six again (having won the Older course in 2021.) In the Top Four in any category for a second time were Potter Hopfensperger, Quinn Minke, Will Kennedy, Brendan Kent, and Sam Boyce
