

E10 SECTION CONCLAVE CODE OF CONDUCT



On my honor, I promise to do my best to comply with the Section E10 Code of Conduct:

As a member of the Order of the Arrow, I hereby acknowledge and agree to the following...

- 1. Abide the Scout Law, Scout Oath, and the Obligation of the Order of the Arrow.
- 2. Wear my officially designated uniform as required throughout the event.
- 3. Attend the planned training sessions.
- 4. Be personally responsible for the breakage, damage, or loss of property.
- 5. Observe quiet hours and lights-out hours.
- 6. Keep my quarters clean and dispose of trash in the proper places.
- 7. Register and pay for all events that I attend.
- 8. Allow no unregistered person to occupy my quarters.
- 9. Sleep in the quarters assigned to me.
- 10. Wear shirts and shoes in accordance with BSA policy.
- 11. No alcohol or illegal drugs will be allowed on camp property.
- 12. Observe BSA tobacco use policy.
- 13. Not leave camp without permission of the event adult leadership.
- 14. Park only in designated areas.
- 15. Vehicles with more than two axles are not permitted without explicit permission from event leadership.
- 16. Understand that Conclave is implementing reasonable protocols to reduce the risk of transmission of COVID-19, but transmission is still possible, and agree that I am aware of the risks and the dangers associated with the COVID-19 virus.
- 17. Abide by the BSA Guide to Safe Scouting, including the use of the buddy system by all Scouts under the age of 18.
 - a. Two Scouts of the same sex may be a buddy pair.
 - b. Two Scouts of the opposite sex may NOT be a buddy pair.
- 18. Observe separate sleeping quarters for males/females and youth/adult Arrowmen as identified by lodge/ event leadership, and observe the national age requirements for tent mates (participants sharing a tent must be within two years of age).
