WHY ATTEND?

Learn in-depth about the seven principles of Leave No Trace through a field-based training experience, with a focus on teaching Leave No Trace to others in Scouting.

Scouters age 18 or older who are interested in learning in-depth about the principles of Leave No Trace and their application, teaching others through training courses such as Leave No Trace Basics, and running Leave No Trace Level 1 Instructor courses in their Districts and Councils.

- Conduct Leave No Trace Level 1 courses
- Deliver other Leave No Trace and Outdoor Ethics trainings
- Lead discussions on Outdoor Ethics with local Troops, Packs, Crews, and Ships as they prepare for outings
- Train and mentor youth to serve as Outdoor Ethics Guides in their units
- Provide leadership on Outdoor Ethics matters to the District and Council, drawing upon a wealth of knowledge and personal experience
