



Scouting America Cub Archery Rangemaster Training

This training is open to registered members of Scouting America (BSA) that are 18 years of age or older.

Scouting America Cub Archery Rangemaster:

This course is required to run an Archery or Slingshot Range for a District or Council Cub Scout event. This course provides Scouting America Cub Archery Rangemasters with the knowledge, skills, and attitude essential to organizing, conducting, and supervising safe shooting activities and range operations.

This course will be taught at the Schapiro Scout Service Center of the Baltimore Area Council in Baltimore MD. You must be at least 18 years of age and be a registered Scouter in Scouting America to take this course. The course is to be taught in three sections.

In **Section I** you will be taught How to Set Up an Outdoor Target Archery Range, a Brief History of Archery, Safety, Equipment and its Use, Maintenance and Storage, Range Layout, Range Operation Rules.

In **Section II** you will be taught Archery Shooting Basics, Targets and Scoring, Proper Whistle Commands, Archery Practice Fun.

In **Section III** you will be taught Training Cub Scouts, Shooting a Competitive Round, Archery Games & Activities, Cub Scouts and Archery, Cub Scout Range and Target Elective Adventures, Slingshots.

To attend this training, you must complete your registration with the Baltimore Area Council. After your registration has been completed with the Council, you will be contacted by the USA Archery Instructor or BSA Range Activities Director that will be instructing the course. You will also be provided with additional information regarding the training.

The Scouting America Cub Archery Rangemaster training course will begin at 1 pm on April 5th and will conclude by 4 pm. You must be present for the entire course to complete the full training. Upon the successful completion of the Scouting America Cub Archery Rangemaster course, you will receive a Training Course Certificate which is good for two years. This training must be renewed every two years.
