



NRA Range Safety Officer Training

This discounted training is open to registered members of Scouting America (BSA) that are 21 years of age or older.

NRA Range Safety Officer Course Description:

Develops NRA Certified Range Safety Officers with the knowledge, skills, and attitude essential to organizing, conducting, and supervising safe shooting activities and range operations.

This course is nine hours long and is conducted in a classroom and at a shooting facility. Range Safety Officer candidates must be at least 21 years of age and will learn roles and responsibilities of an RSO; Range Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs); range inspection; range rules; range briefings; emergency procedures; and firearm stoppages and malfunctions. Each Range Safety Officer Candidate will receive an RSO Student Study Guide, a Basic Firearm Training Program brochure, an NRA Gun Safety Rules brochure, and a Course Evaluation form.

Students must attend this one-day training course in its entirety. The course will be held at Camp Saffran at the Broad Creek Memorial Scout Reservation. Lunch will be provided.

To attend this NRA training you must complete your registration with the Baltimore Area Council. After your registration has been completed with the Council, you will be contacted by the NRA Chief Range Safety Officer or NRA Training Counselor that will be instructing the course. You will be provided with the link to register for the course on the NRA Training website as well as any additional information regarding the training.

The NRA Range Safety Officer course will begin at 8 am on June 7th. Training should conclude by 5 pm. You must be present for the entire course to complete the full training.

All NRA training materials and hearing and eye protection will be provided. Personal firearms or ammunition are not permitted on camp property.

Cost: \$35.00

Note: There is a credentialing fee with the NRA which is not included in the cost of this training. NRA membership is not required to become an NRA Instructor.
