

2024 Fort Snelling National Cemetery Service Project Instructions

The forecast is that it will still be winter!! It is critical that everyone dress for the weather and stay dry to avoid hypothermia or worse. Please supervise younger Scouts to not get wet playing in the snow and watch for frostbite.

You will be near your cars.

If you get cold, get into the cars. If you're really too cold, just go home!

The person who completes the online registration process will receive an email with a copy of the Ft. Snelling National Cemetery map showing the assigned entrance gate and work area. We will have staff at each gate to answer questions and keep traffic moving as quickly as possible.

COVID Safety: Please be cognizant that Covid is still with us. If anyone in your group is not feeling well the day of this event, please thank them for signing up, but keep them at home.

We believe this outdoor activity is reasonably safe. Social Distance from anyone not in your own household as much as possible.

The staff for this event are members of the Order of the Arrow, youth and adult. They can be identified by their red-and-white Arrow sashes. Please cooperate with them.

Work Areas: After arrival, please proceed to your assigned Work Area. Units will be assigned to work together. **Park only on one side of any street**, so vehicles picking up the wreaths have access.

Cleanup instructions: Remove wreaths and any other Christmas decorations from the gravesites, but **do not remove** any other type of floral or memorial decorations, etc. Leave in place anything frozen into the ground; adults may need to help cut loose items wired to them.

Place the removed items in piles along the roads for pick-up.

When you finish a Zone, **PLEASE STAY NEAR YOUR PILES, AND WAIT FOR A TRUCK TO COME and THEN HELP LOAD IT!** We hope to have many trucks and/or trailers so your wait won't be long.
