NSS CVOA Presents: 2024 Urban AdVenturing

Explore the Twin Cities! Strategize! Find way-points! Post pictures!

Summary

Scouts start from the South Metro Transit Parking Lot (Ft. Snelling Station) near Base Camp and **ride Metro Transit LRT & Buses** to places and objects of interest, called way-points. The race begins when the way-points are released. Crews take pictures of each way-point with their crew and post the pictures to social media to earn points. The AdVenture race **ends at 4:30 pm**; any photos posted after will not count. Whichever crew earns the most points will be declared winner at a pizza reception to follow.

Teams~Crews

Venturing Crews, Sea Scout Ships, Explorer Posts, and Scouts BSA Troops will participate as "crews". Crews are encouraged to recruit non-scouters to participate. Crews with a non-scouter(can't be siblings) participating will get a 50 point bonus per non-scouter.

Equipment

- Smart phone capable of posting to Instagram and use of Remind
 - A second different phone, for updates
 - A charger and battery bank
- Weather appropriate apparel
- Urban AdVenture placard/sign (will be provided)
- Money/lunch
- Water Bottle
- Metro Transit Day Pass (Provided by the VOA for those who have pre registered)

Way-points

- Each way-point has a value. Way-points further away tend to have higher values
- Way-points are public and include businesses, parks, points-of-interest, landmarks and other general locations
- Bonus way-points may be announced throughout the day
 - These are typically high value and have a limited time or first-to-get-to

Rules

- Pictures
 - ALL crew members must be visible (except photographer) *** limbs don't count except for certain on the ground ones
 - Must include the Urban AdVenture placard/sign
 - Only scouting appropriate pictures
 - Honor any non-crew member who requests you not photograph them or ask permission before taking a picture with them in it
 - Posts must include required tags to be counted (more on required tags below)
- Crews may not split up. Travel together and practice the Buddy System
- Crews are responsible for their own lunch (money or their own food)
- Remember you represent your crew, Northern Star Council, and Scouts BSA
- Two deep leadership is required
- Follow the traffic rules of the road
- Teams may only use public transportation. Private vehicles will not be permitted. No Uber, Lyft, or Rideshare services.
- No use of lyme(electric rental) bikes or scooters
- All Venturing Officers Association decisions are final
- All Crews must check-out before leaving

Earning Points

- Crews travel to their selection of way-points from a list provided at the start of the event
- At the way-point, the crew will take a picture with the way-point, all crew members, &
 the Urban AdVenture placard/sign
- The photo will be uploaded via the Instagram account given to VOA
 - Tag @NorthernstarBSA, @NSCVenturing, and the account you are assigned on the day off by Urban Adventure staff
 - Ensure the post is public
 - Write way-point location in description
 - Include all the following hashtags
 - #<CREW NAME>
 - #urbanadventure24
 - #VenturingBSA
- Points will not be awarded if a photo does not meet criteria
- Command Central will monitor the provided account and keep a total of your points
- Bonus points
 - Command Central may announce opportunities for bonus points via Remind, throughout the day
 - May come in the form of way-points or special tasks

Starting and Way-points

- When the way-points are released, the race begins
- Crews will determine optimal route based off way-point locations
- There is no required order, nor must all be collected
- Youth members of the crew are in-charge for this event. Adults are present to guide and help make sure Youth members act with safety in mind

Check-Out

 All crews must check-out before leaving the event to return materials and so we can confirm all crews get back safely!
