Snelling National Cemetery by removing over 40,000 Christmas wreaths placed in memorial on grave sites for the holiday season. It's an effort that is both fun and meaningful. All Cubs, Scouts BSA, Venturers, family, community members, and anyone else wishing to help are welcome!!

Location: Fort Snelling National Cemetery

From Highways 494 and 5, exit to 34th Avenue, North. Gates to Cemetery will be on your right.

Please pre-register online for this event! This provides us with the information needed to make sure all work areas within the cemetery have enough participants to efficiently remove the wreaths and transport them to the dumpster locations.
