What requirements can you get done at the science fair?

If have a Nova Mentor already than we will be doing the following.

- 1. Participate in a science project or experiment in your classroom or school. Discuss this activity with your mentor.
- 2. Do ONE of the following:
- A. Visit with someone who works in a STEM-related career. Discuss what you learned with your mentor.
- B. Learn about a career that depends on knowledge about science, technology, engineering, or mathematics. Discuss what you learned with your mentor.
- 3. Under the direct supervision of your mentor, do an experiment that shows how the scientific method (or scientific process) is used. Prepare a short report on the results of your experiment for your mentor.
- 4. Participate in a Nova- or other STEM-related activity in your Webelos Scout den or pack meeting that is conducted by a Boy Scout or Venturer who is working on his or her Supernova award. If this is not possible, participate in another Nova- or STEM-related activity in your den or pack meeting.

If you do not have a mentor we can work on setting you up with one to get the other requirements completed.

All kids who show up will get a patch and the top 3 will get trophies.
