



## Publicity Waiver and Release

Boy Scouts of America, Territory 11 Host Councils, Massachusetts, Connecticut, and Rhode Island not for profit corporations (“**MassJam Committee aka MassJam**”) desires to use and publicize the name, likeness, and other personal characteristics of the individual named below with a residence at the address set out below (“**I**” or “**me**”) for advertising, promotion, and other commercial and business purposes. In exchange for the intangible value I will gain by participating in MassJam’s publicity programs and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which I hereby acknowledge, I give MassJam my permission for such use and publicity for such purposes, according to the terms and conditions set forth in this Publicity Waiver and Release (“**Agreement**”).

I hereby irrevocably permit, authorize, grant, and license MassJam and its affiliates, successors, and assigns, and their respective licensees, advertising agencies, and promotion agencies, and the employees, officers, directors, and agents of each and all of them (“**Authorized Persons**”), the rights to display, publicly perform, exhibit, transmit, broadcast, reproduce, record, photograph, digitize, modify, alter, edit, adapt, create derivative works, exploit, sell, rent, license, otherwise use, and permit others to use my name, image, likeness, and appearance, and all materials created by or on behalf of MassJam that incorporate any of the foregoing (“**Materials**”) in perpetuity throughout the universe in any medium or format whatsoever now existing or hereafter created, including but not limited to, in and on magazines, brochures and other print publications, display, point-of-sale, and other advertising and promotional materials, press releases, the internet and other digital transmission or delivery methods, and mobile applications, on any platform and for any purpose, including but not limited to advertising, public relations, publicity, packaging, and promotion of MassJam and its affiliates and its licensees and their businesses, products, and services, without further consent from or royalty, payment, or other compensation to me.

MassJam shall be the exclusive owner of all rights, including copyright, in the Materials. I acknowledge and agree that I have no right to review or approve Materials before they are used



by MassJam. Any credit or other acknowledgment of me, if any, shall be determined by MassJam in MassJam’s sole discretion. MassJam has no obligation to create or use the Materials or to exercise any rights given by this Agreement.

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, I hereby irrevocably waive all legal and equitable rights relating to all liabilities, claims, demands, actions, suits, damages, and expenses, including but not limited to claims for copyright or trademark infringement, infringement of moral rights, libel, defamation, invasion of any rights of privacy (including intrusion, false light, public disclosure of private facts, and misappropriation of name or likeness), violation of rights of publicity, physical or emotional injury or distress, or any similar claim or cause of action in tort, contract, or any other legal theory, now known or hereafter known in any jurisdiction throughout the world (collectively, “**Claims**”) arising directly or indirectly from the Authorized Persons’ exercise of their rights under this Agreement, and covenant not to make or bring any such Claim against any Authorized Persons, and forever release and discharge the Authorized Persons from liability under such Claims.

## Parental Authorization Form

### Compliance with Massachusetts State Law Regarding Authorized Use of Firearms by a Minor

The MassJam Committee adheres to all applicable laws and operates under the governance of Boy Scouts of America (BSA) national standards as well as the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Public Health regulatory standards for recreational camps for children. As a part of the BSA program the council operates several safe shooting sports ranges for Scouts/campers to participate in rifle shooting, shotgun, and archery. In order to satisfy Mass General Law Chapter 140 section 130 1/2 the council requires parental permission to participate in such activities. Mass General Law Chapter 140, Section 130 1/2 stipulates the following:

Lawfully furnishing weapons to minors for hunting, recreation, instruction and participation in shooting sports.

Notwithstanding section 130 or any general or special law to the contrary, it shall be lawful to furnish a weapon to a minor for hunting, recreation, instruction and participation in shooting sports while under the supervision of a holder of a valid firearm identification card or license to carry appropriate for the weapon in use; provided, however, that the parent or guardian of the minor granted consent for such activities.

### Use of Hand Sanitizer

The Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH) requires written permission for child use of hand sanitizer. Hand sanitizer can be utilized when a sink for hand washing with soap and water is not available. MDPH encourages the use of hand sanitizer with alcohol content of 60% or higher for children upon arrival to the entrance of the camp. Children will also be encouraged to wash their hands upon arrival to each program area throughout the day. Hand sanitizer is always kept out of the reach of children. Children will be monitored closely with its use to make sure they rub their hands completely dry, so they do not get sanitizer in their eyes or mouth. Please indicate below if you give permission for your child to use hand sanitizer under camp/event staff supervision at MassJam.

- I hereby authorize my child to participate in all events, if age appropriate, in the shooting sports program areas (Rifle and Shotgun are under supervision of a FID or LTC instructor).
