









Safety Minute: Winter Outdoor Safety Tips


- Planning & Hazard Awareness
 - Check Advisories, Route Map, Share Plan, Time Buffer
- Gear & Preparedness
 - Layering, Rest Break Layer, Stay Warm, Essentials, Emergency Kit
- Risk Management & Safe Travel
 - Monitor, Adjust, Turn Around, Buddy System, Teach, STOP
- Emergency Kit Essentials
 - Supplies, Layers, Charge devices/batteries, First Aid Kit, Emergency plan

The mission of Scouting America is to prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetimes by installing in them the values of the Scout Oath and Law



Summer Camp Research | Ryan Piazza | Camping Director


Towson University conducted a study “The Effects of a Summer Camp Experience on Factors of Resilience in At-Risk Youth” with some interesting findings.

- Results showed statistically significant differences in the campers’ belief of a good future for themselves.
- Campers reported sustained or positive growth in domains of social skills and positive values from the baseline to a six-month follow up.
- The camp environment expands positive choice and availability of positive occupations



- Opportunities for personal growth, leadership development, and making summer memories that last.






Unit OA Elections | Anush | OA Lodge

- Throughout the weeks at summer camp, Wednesday is always OA Call Out
- This is a time, where future Arrowmen may be recognized for being elected into the Order
- In order to get recognized, a unit must complete an election prior to camp at Unit meetings before May 31st
 - There is an option to host elections at camp, but it is much more effective and useful if units conduct their elections at meetings instead of Summer Camp
 - A list of election proctors will be available from anytime between Monday to Sunday to run these elections
 - In order to have an election, a **Unit Leader must request an election in Lodgemaster**
- Elections are a perfect opportunity to get involved and see first hand what our Lodge, Tantamous Lodge is all about!


CampDoc | David Repeta | Camp Squanto Asst. Camp Director

- AHMR Part C (resident programs only) must be printed out, completed by a physician, and re-uploaded (do not accept annual physical forms by primary)
- Only one AHMR and Release are required per camper regardless of the number of summer programs.
- Camp Health Officers will be able to access camper information, organize data, run reports.
- CampDoc will provide first-line customer support for units and families.
- Main Registration Contact can now view campdoc status under troop registration



CampDoc | David Repeta | Camp Squanto Asst. Camp Director

- All medications brought into camp, MUST be entered into Campdocs, even OTC Meds.
- Epi-Pens and inhalers need to be entered as a medication on the medication tab.
- If a camper is pausing a med during the camp session, it needs to be noted in Campdocs or removed.
- Dietary concerns/restrictions must be entered in Campdocs on the dietary tab.
- ALL Camper meds MUST be stored at the health lodge and administered by the Health Officer.
- Campers are defined as any attendee under the age of 18.




Alumni Nights | Alumni Association

- Fellowship with fellow alumni and current staff





Campmaster Program



- Establish a group of **selected, trained and registered Scouters** who serve at our camp properties (weekend, unit-use).
- Each volunteer (Campmaster) chooses how often to serve (e.g., 1 to 3 times/year) depending on availability.
- They work under the leadership of the council Camping Committee and report to the Scout Executive or Director of Support Services.
- Selection criteria include: outdoor skills, knowledge of nature/conservation, leadership ability, ability to relate to people and act in emergencies.
- Basic duties: unit check-in on arrival, commissioner-type service, orientation to camp resources (water, firewood, latrines), assist with checkout & facility condition, occasionally run the trading post.
- Additional service examples: helping new leaders set up campsite, organizing inter-unit activities or campfires, conservation efforts, creating check-in/out schedules.
- Must be a **registered Scouter/volunteer with BSA** (or your chartering organization) to be eligible.
- Must have a working knowledge of Scouting (your organization's program) and be able to demonstrate leadership and outdoor/technical abilities.
- The formal application: submit a nomination or application form, to be reviewed for acceptance into the Campmaster Corps
- Attend a Campmaster training program provided by the council (or your equivalent)


