AUTHORIZATION FOR RELEASE OF CAMPER

It is the policy of the Michigan Crossroads Council, the Boy Scouts of America, and the state of Michigan to release a camper only to an authorized person listed on the BSA Health & Medical Record and/or the "Release Camper" form utilized by units attending Cole Canoe Base due to the proximity of the health lodge from the camp office. Only units attending Cole Canoe Base need to fill out a "Release of Camper" form in addition to the BSA Health form, which will be collected during the check-in process.

Any person requesting permission to remove a camper from the premises whose name does not appear on the camper's "Release of Camper" form, shall not be granted said permission at the advice, consent, and signature of authorized of the Unit Leader. In order for such authorization to be granted the Unit Leader MUST contact the parent/legal guardian of the camper and get verbal consent of release.

If the Unit Leader is unable to obtain and certify verbal consent, and the name of the person trying to release the camper from camp is not listed on the "Release of Camper" form, the Scout will not be released to the individual.

The Michigan Crossroads Council and Boy Scouts of America are not responsible for any camper(s) released by the Unit Leader, once the camper has left the premises.
