Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops (ILST) is a leadership course for Scouts BSA youth interested in taking a leadership role in their Troop, whether that is Patrol Leader, Senior Patrol Leader or any other position. Scouts run the Troop: planning the Troop calendar, leading meetings/activities, and guiding problem-solving when needed. This course provides training in communication, Troop organization/structure, planning, team development and conflict resolution.

There is no cost for this training; registration is required for planning & materials.

This course is a one-day preview of and a pre-requisite to the weeklong leadership course known as National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT). Because ILST is focused on how the individual Troop should be led, at least two youth plus a Scoutmaster/Asst. Scoutmaster must register and attend together.
